 - Is over 60 years of age
 - Is receiving treatments for cancer
 - Has a compromised immune system
 - Is taking certain medications

Are Shingles common?

- Almost 1 out of 3 people in America will develop shingles (herpes zoster) during their lifetime.
- Nearly 1 million Americans experience the condition each year.
- About half of all shingles cases occur in people age 60 years or older.
