What: Flu clinics will be offered by the Health Department beginning in October. Shots are restricted until October 24, 2005.

Vaccination this year will occur in 2 “waves” – the first wave will be from October 1 through October 23, 2005 and is for high risk clients only.

High risk categories include:

- people aged 65 years and older, with and without chronic health conditions
- residents of long-term care facilities
- people aged 2–64 years with chronic health conditions
- children aged 6–23 months and pregnant women
- health-care personnel who provide direct patient care
- household contacts and out-of-home caregivers of children less than 6 months of age

2nd Wave – October 24 and beyond - All other persons wishing to receive a flu shot

Last year in our tri-county area more than 6,000 people went to their doctor with flu-like symptoms. In a bad flu season, more than 30,000 in our 3 county region will get the flu.

Cost: Flu vaccines from the Community Health Agency this year will cost \$20.00. If you have Medicare Part B and you bring your card, there is no charge for your shot.

Symptoms of Flu

- High fever, runny or stuffy nose
- muscle aches
- Nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea (more common in children)
- headache
- extreme tiredness
- dry cough; sore throat
