The Branch-Hillsdale-St. Joseph Community Health Agency will be having an H1N1 vaccination clinic in St. Joseph County, this Saturday, November 21, 2009 at the St. Joseph County Intermediate School District building, located at 62445 Shimmel Rd, in Centreville, Michigan. This clinic will be open from 9:00am to 12:00 noon. The clinic is for vaccination of the following target groups only:

- Young adults ages 18-24
- Children 6 months to 5 years of age
- Mothers/Dads & care givers of children under 6 months of age,
- Pregnant women
- Persons 6-64 with chronic medical conditions (diabetes, asthma, lung and kidney disease, blood disorders)

Please note; this clinic is not intended for school age children as our school clinics are now underway and those kids will be vaccinated at their school. Young adults ages 18 to 24 are not typically vaccinated in a school clinic so they are being added to this weekends clinic.

There is no fee associated with these vaccinations.

Vaccines supplies are limited and vaccinations will be given until the vaccine supply is gone, or until 12 noon.
