Skin Cancer Awareness!

Nearly 5 million people are treated for skin cancer each year in the United States. Spending time outdoors is a terrific way to improve your overall health and wellness; reduce stress; promote mental health and stimulate vitamin D production in the skin. However, your body can only take in a limited amount of vitamin D at one time. Too much ultraviolet exposure can increase your risk for skin cancer, the most common cancer in the United States.

The Branch-Hillsdale-St. Joseph Community Health Agency is proud to participate in Skin Cancer Awareness. Join us in acting to prevent skin cancer by taking these steps today to protect your skin:

- Stay in the shade especially between the hours of 10am and 4pm
- Wear clothing that covers your arms and legs
- Wear sunglasses that block both ultraviolet A rays and ultraviolet B rays
- Use sunscreen with sun protection factor 15 or higher and both ultraviolet A and B protection
- Avoid indoor tanning beds.

- Check your skin regularly for changes
- Do not burn
