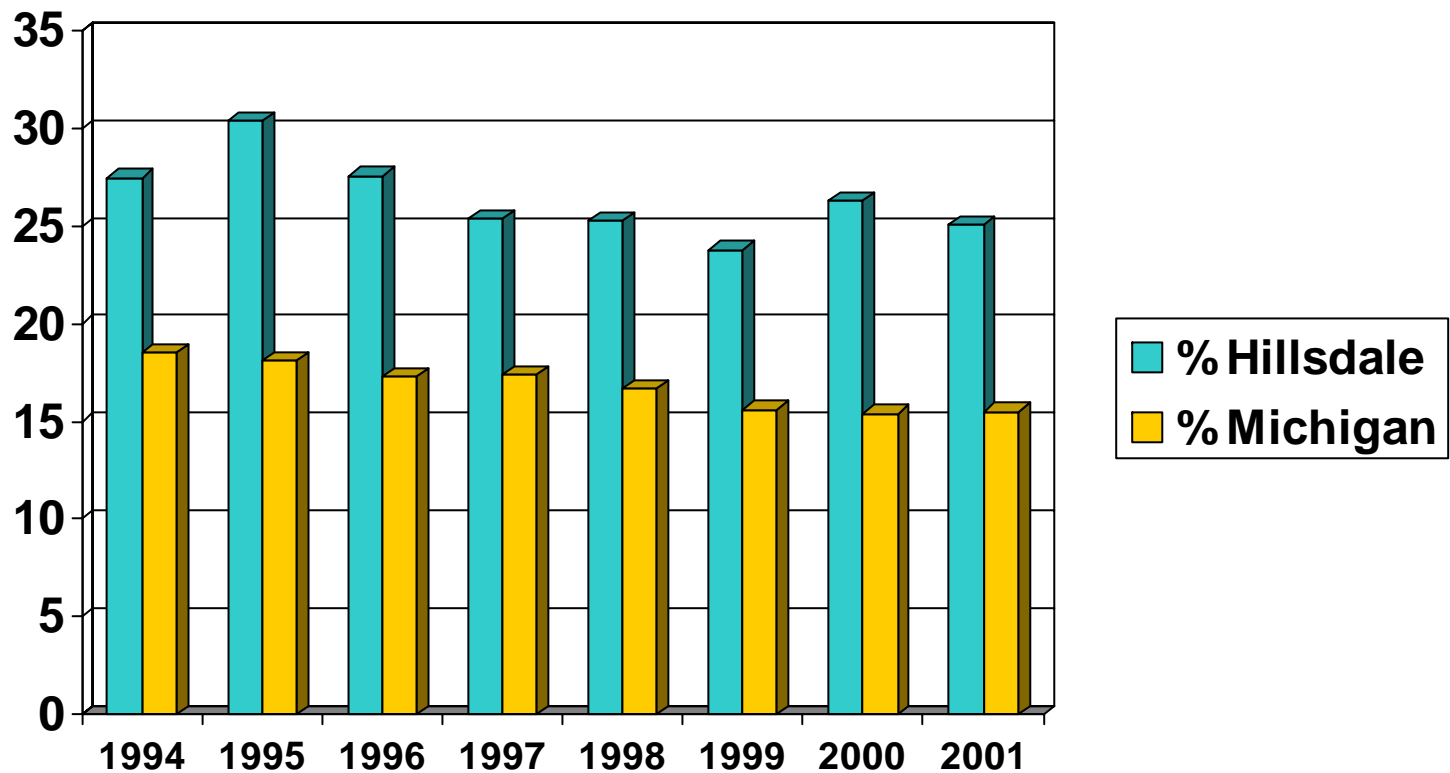

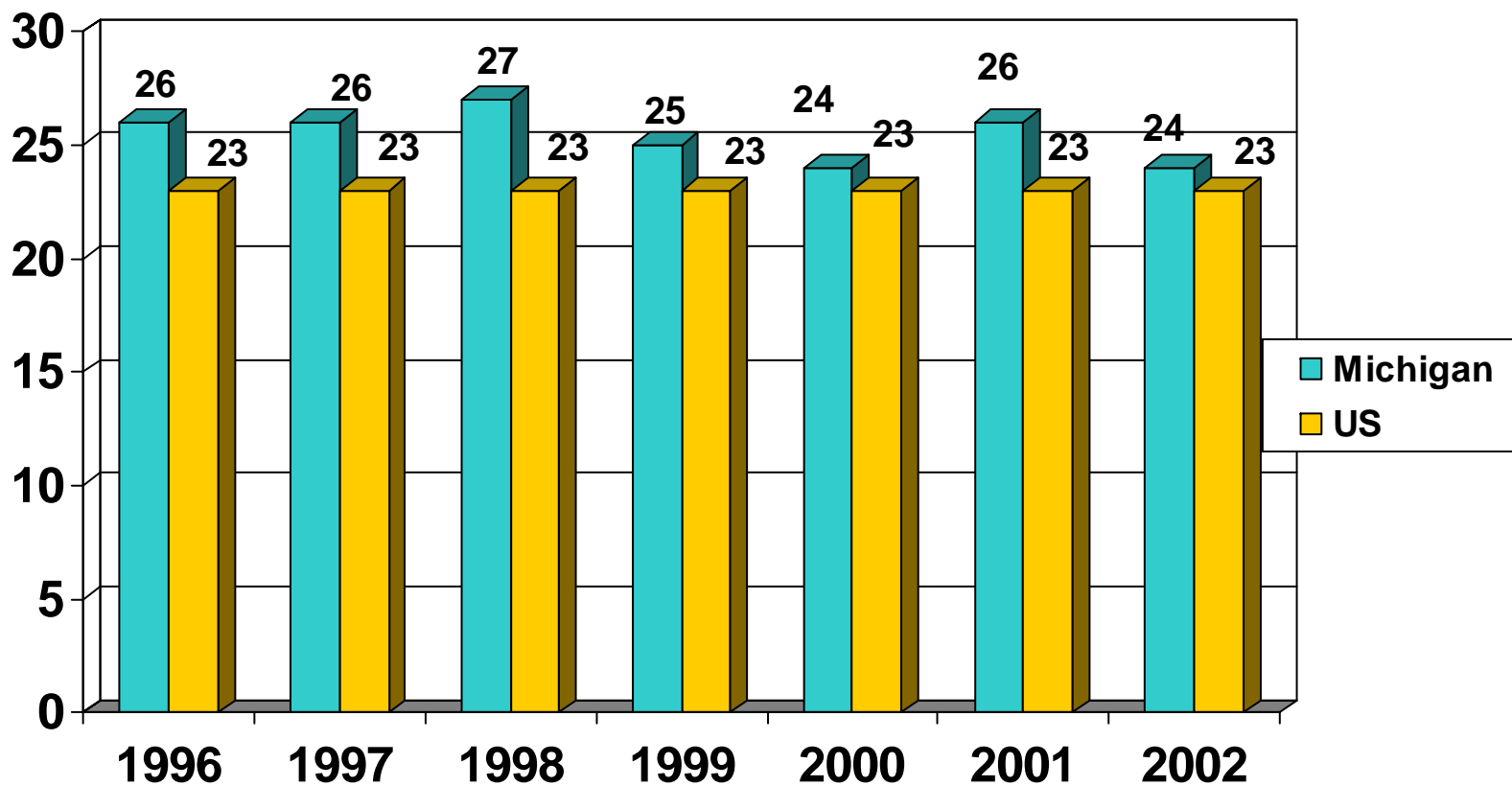
# Mothers who smoked during Pregnancy – Hillsdale County vs. Michigan, 1994-2001

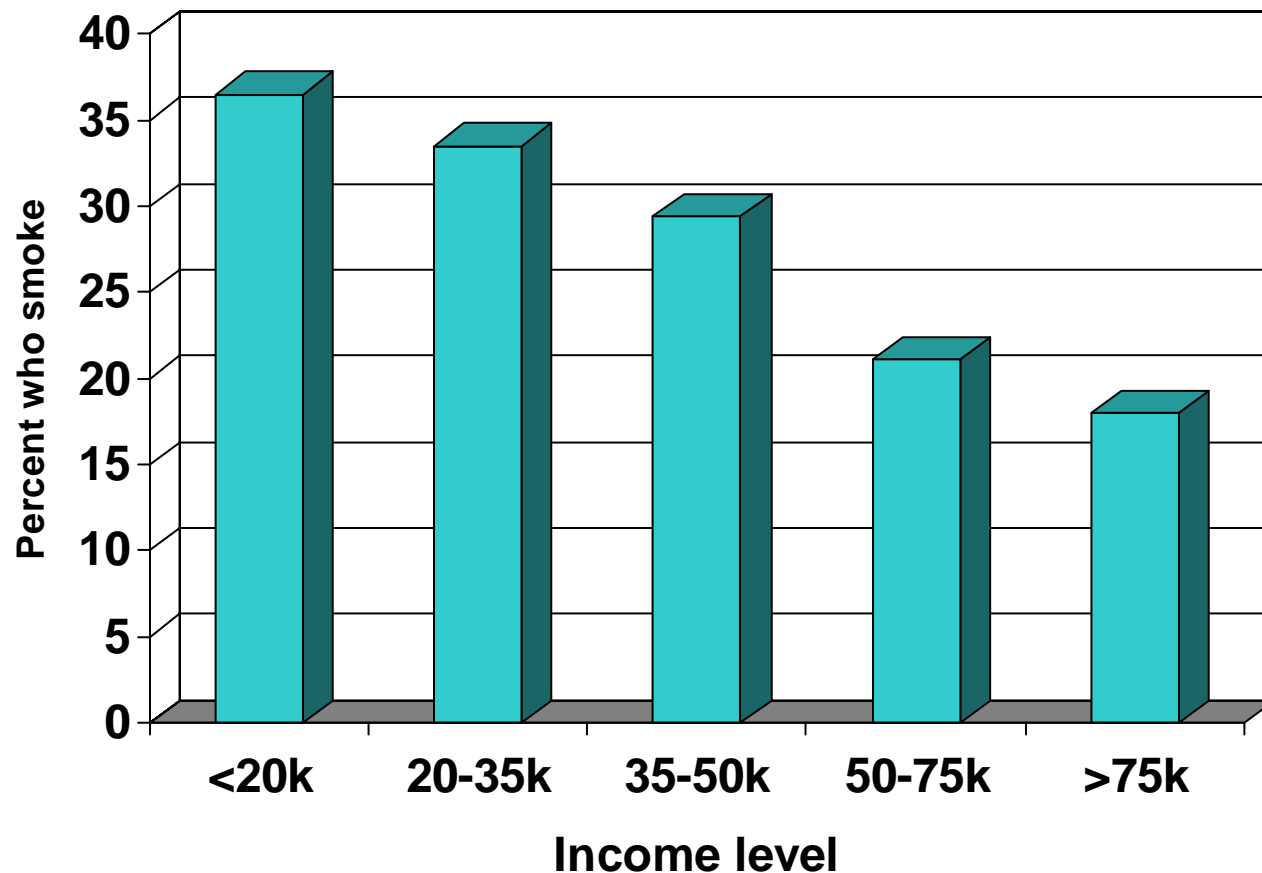
# Current smokers Michigan vs. US

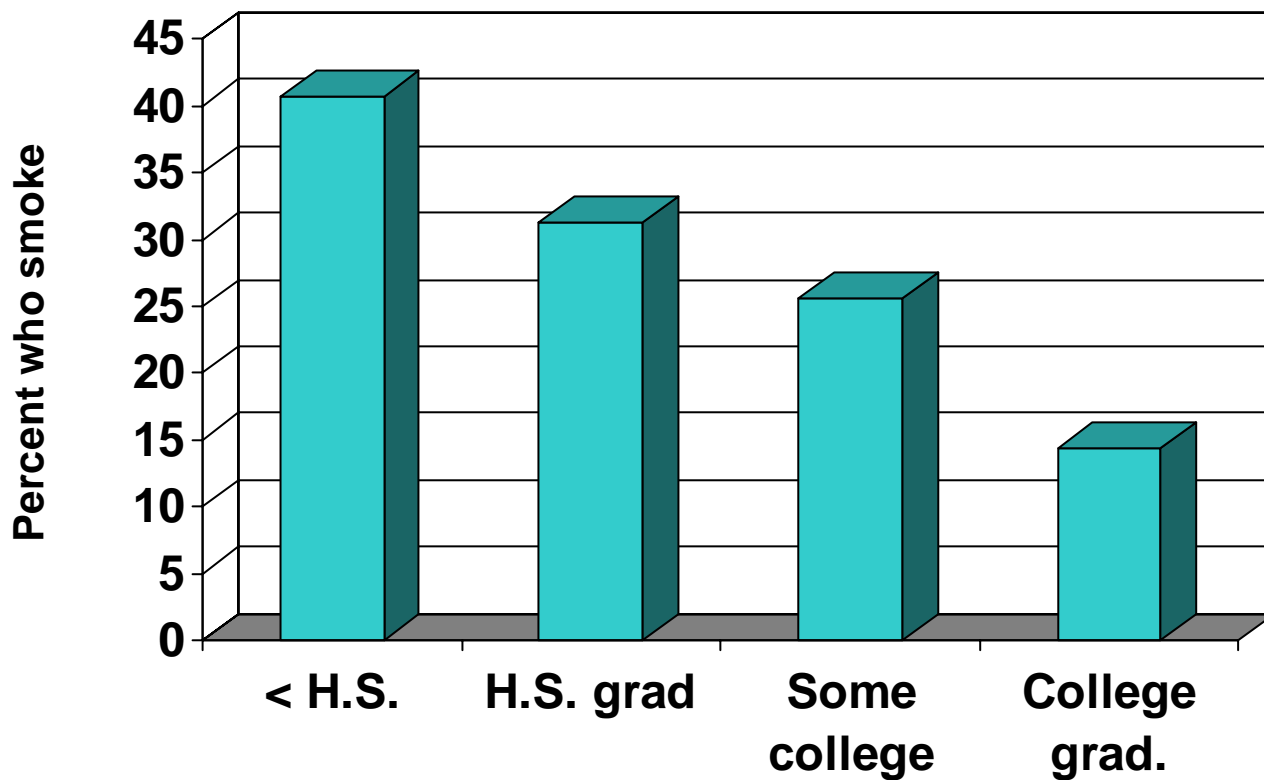
# Smoking vs. Income level- Michigan

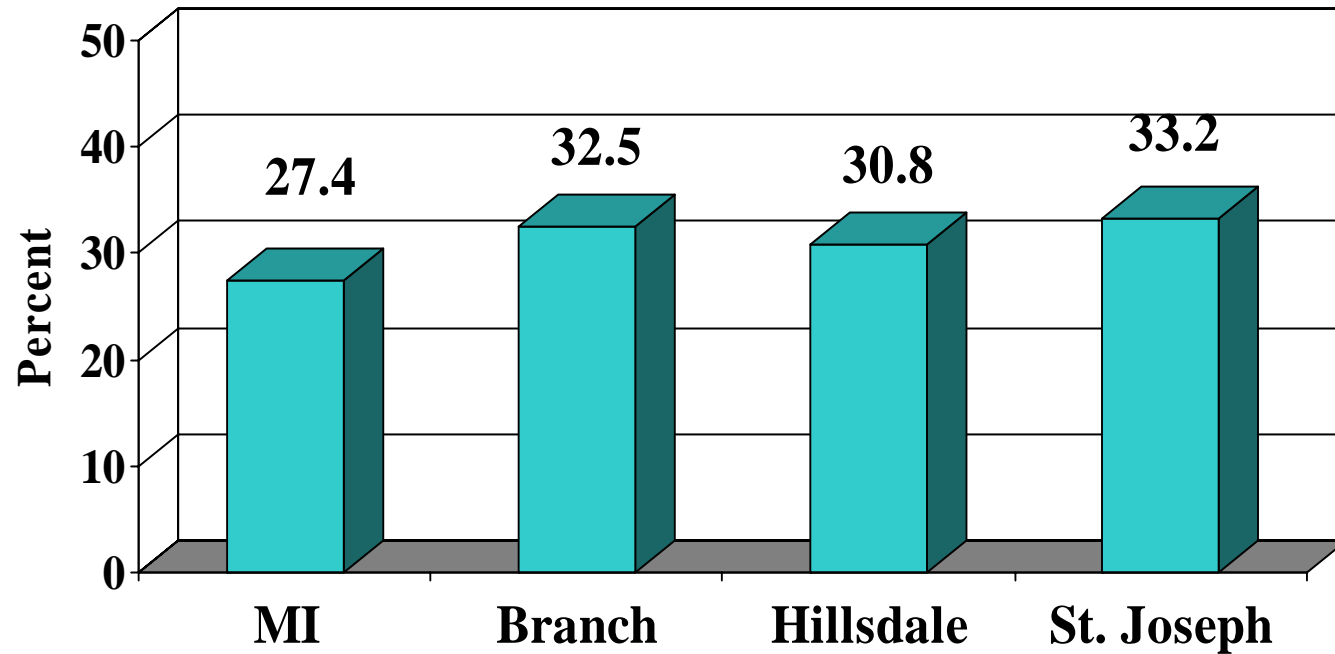

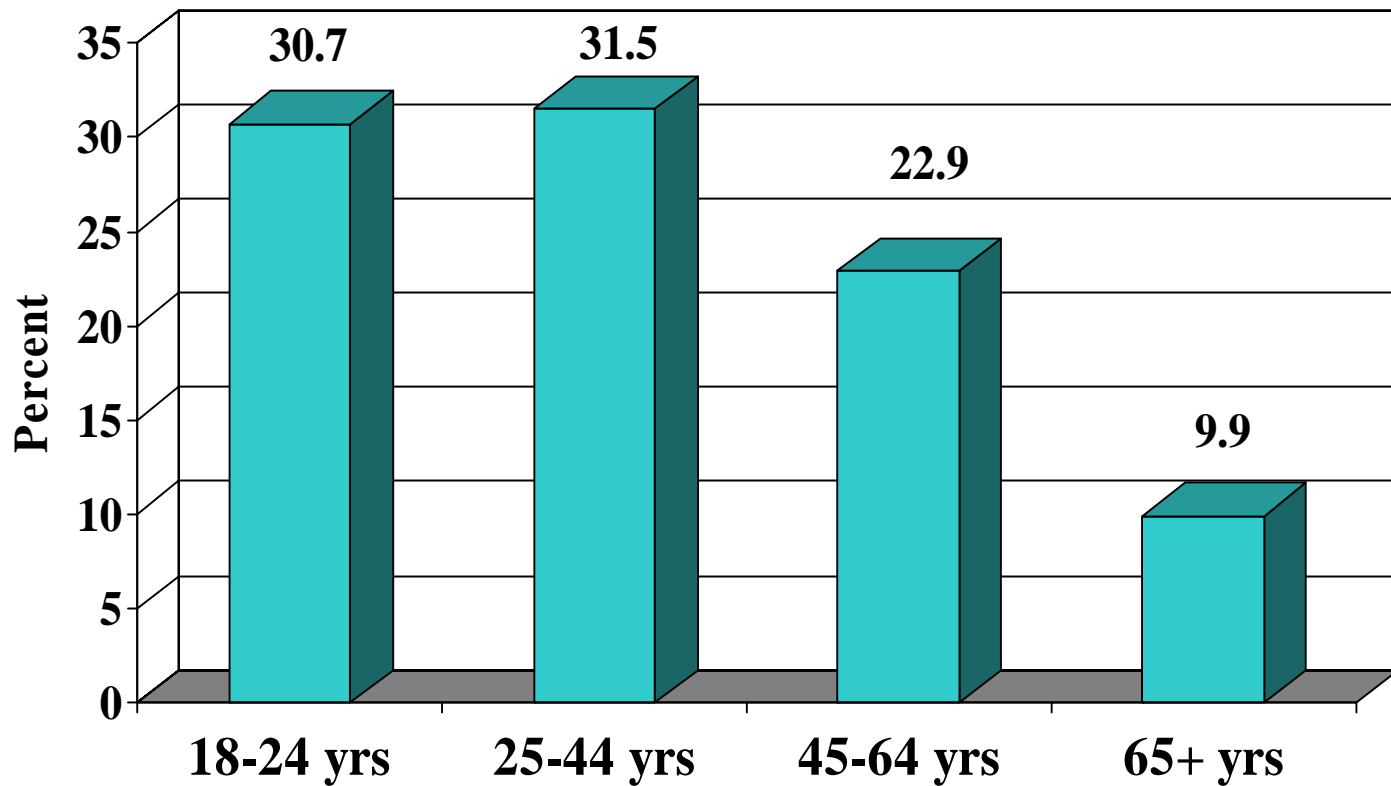
**% Current smokers/MI and by County**

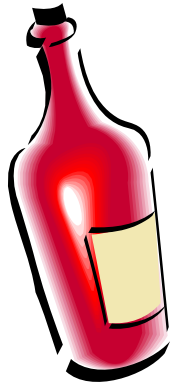

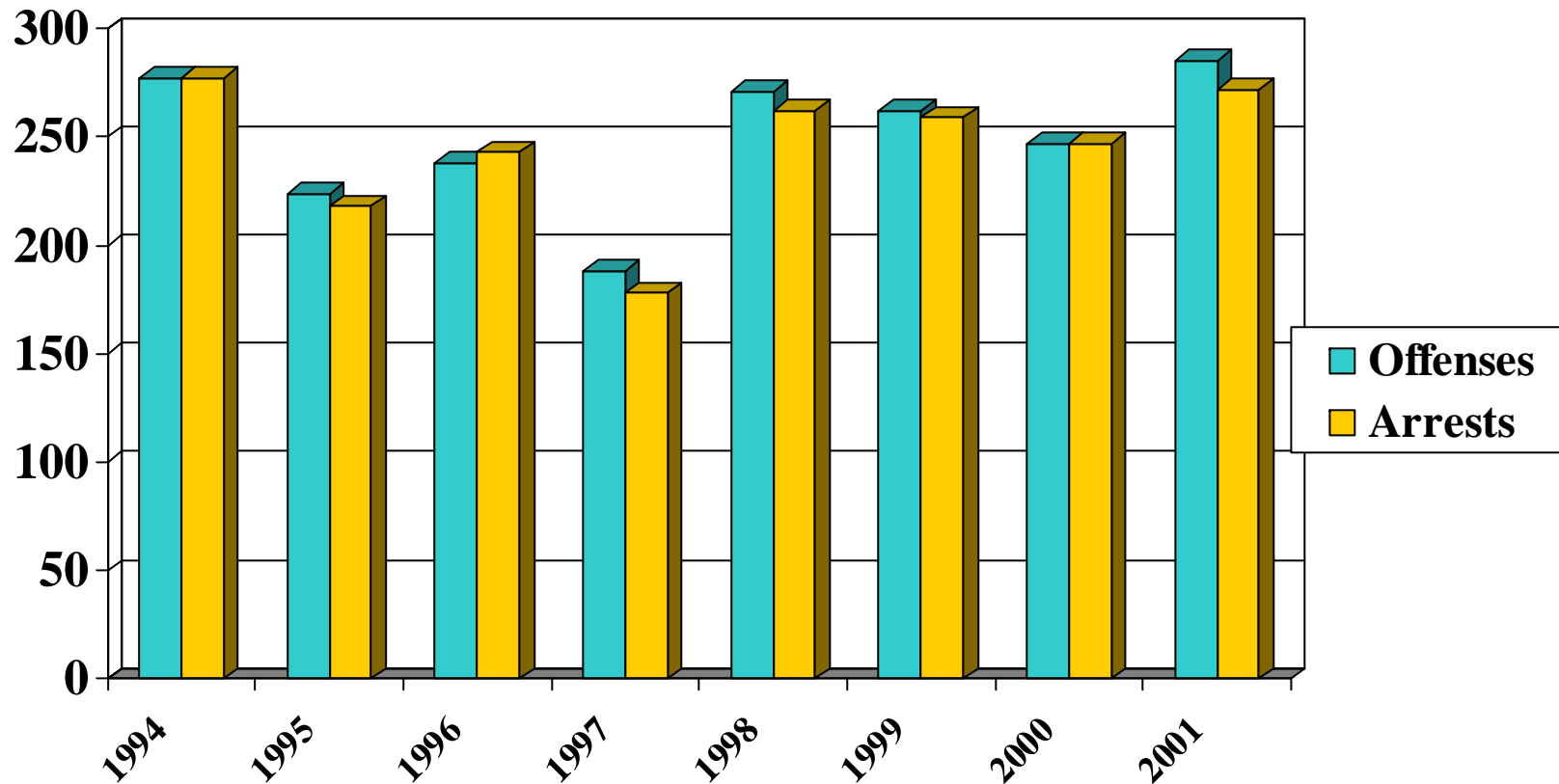

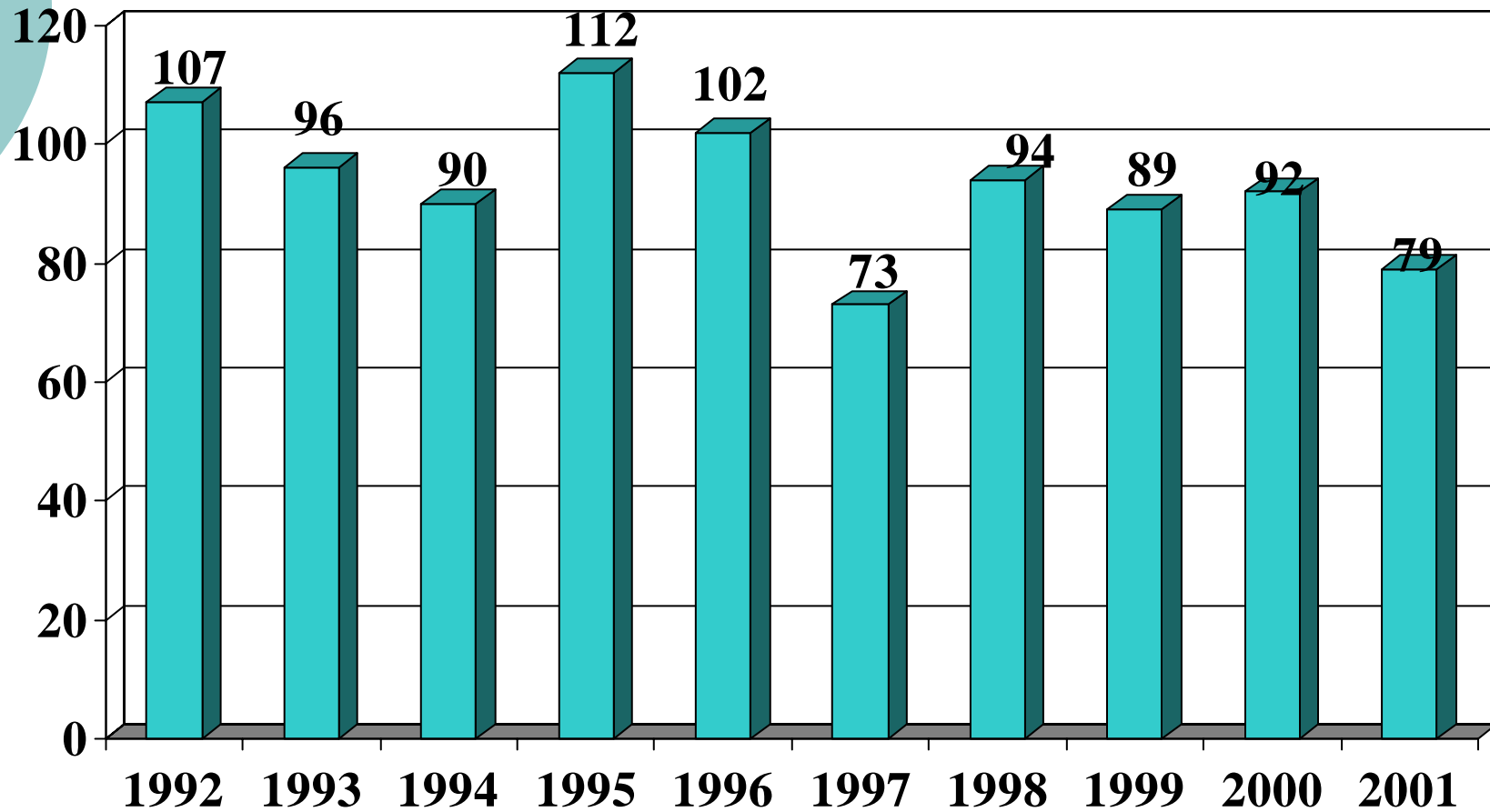
# Offenses and arrests for DUI, Hillsdale County 1990-2001

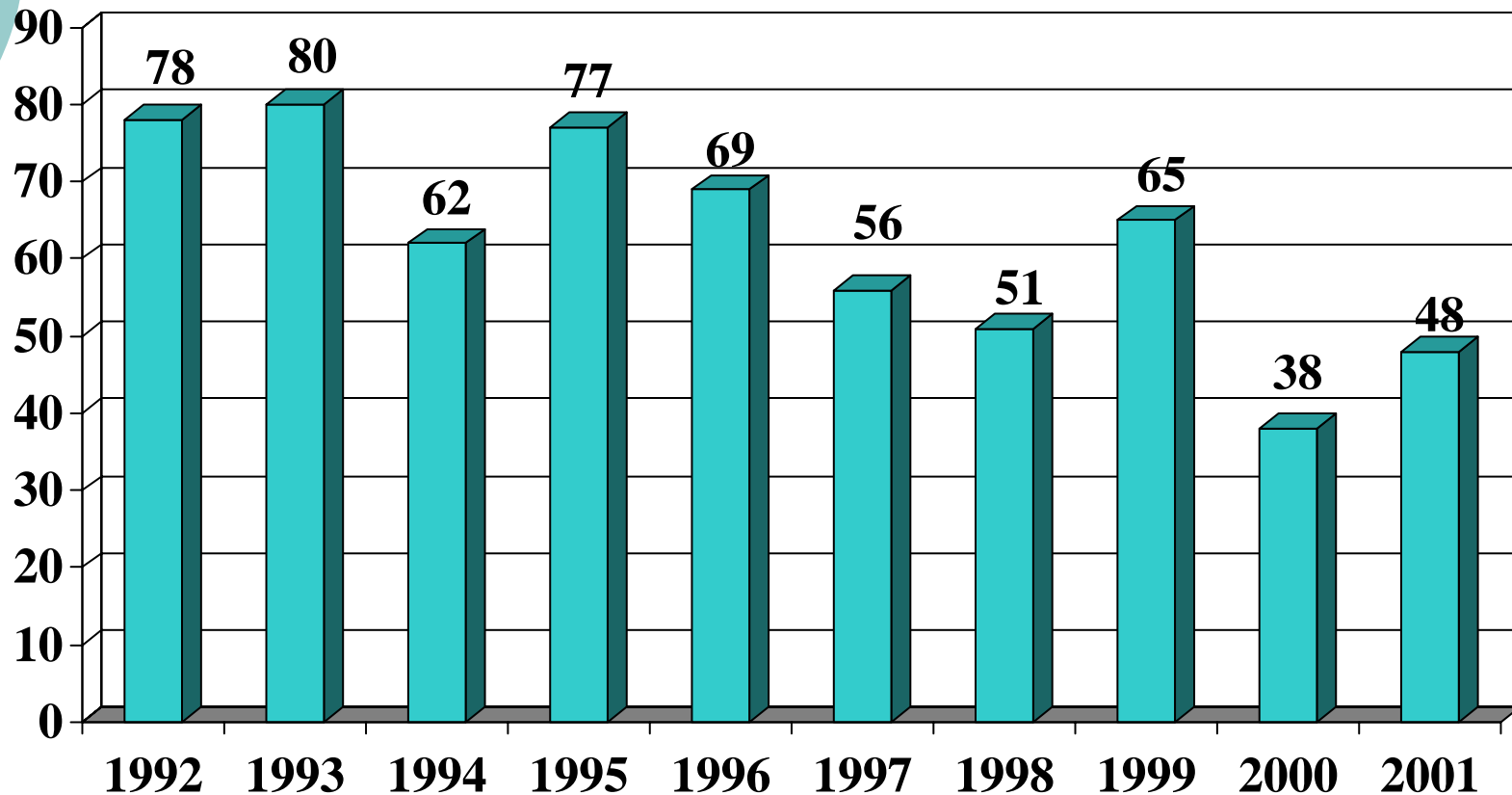
# Motor vehicle accidents involving driving when impaired, Hillsdale County

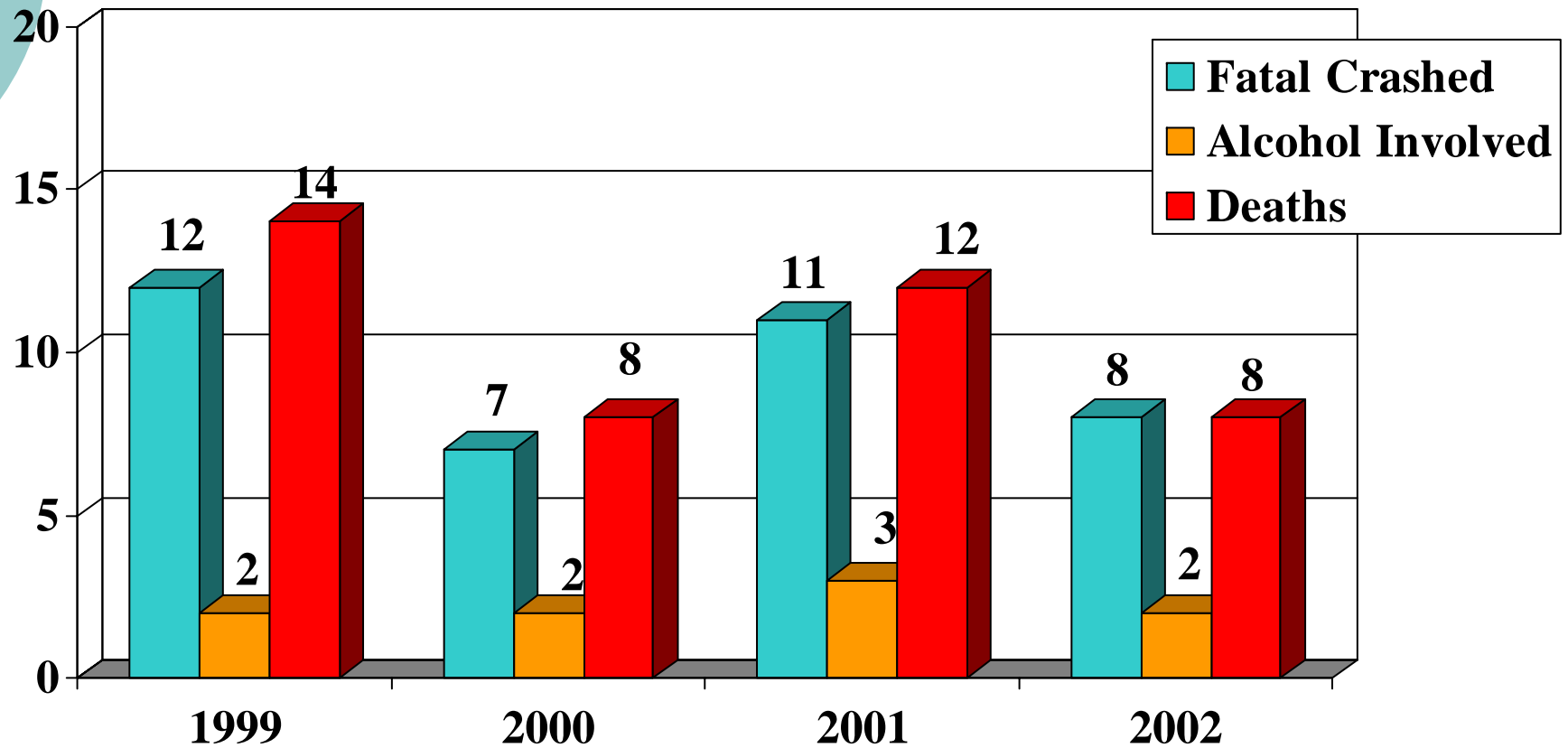
# Number injured in motor vehicle accidents involving driving when impaired, Hillsdale County 1992-2001

# Number killed in motor vehicle accidents with alcohol involved - Hillsdale County 1999-2002

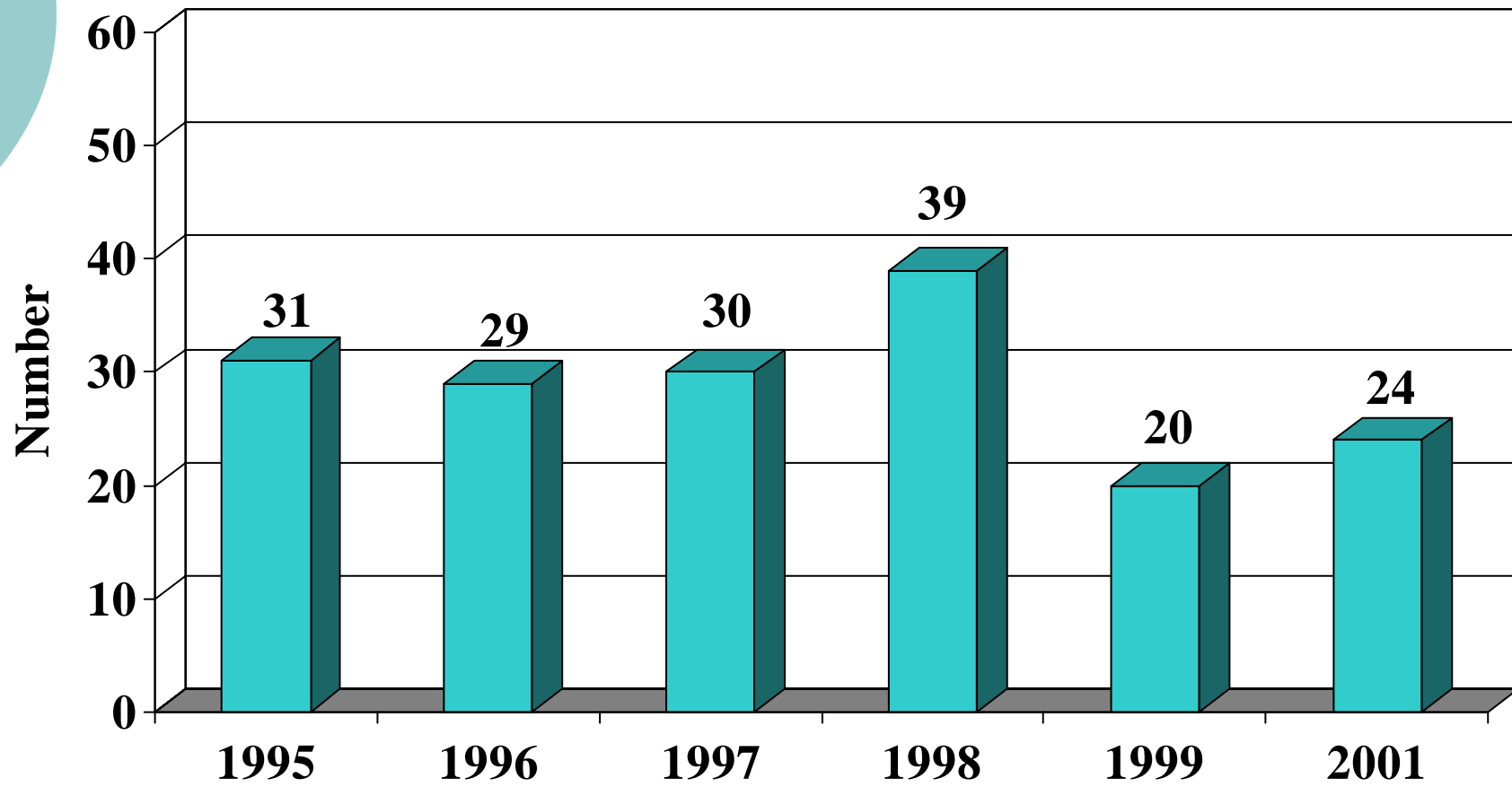

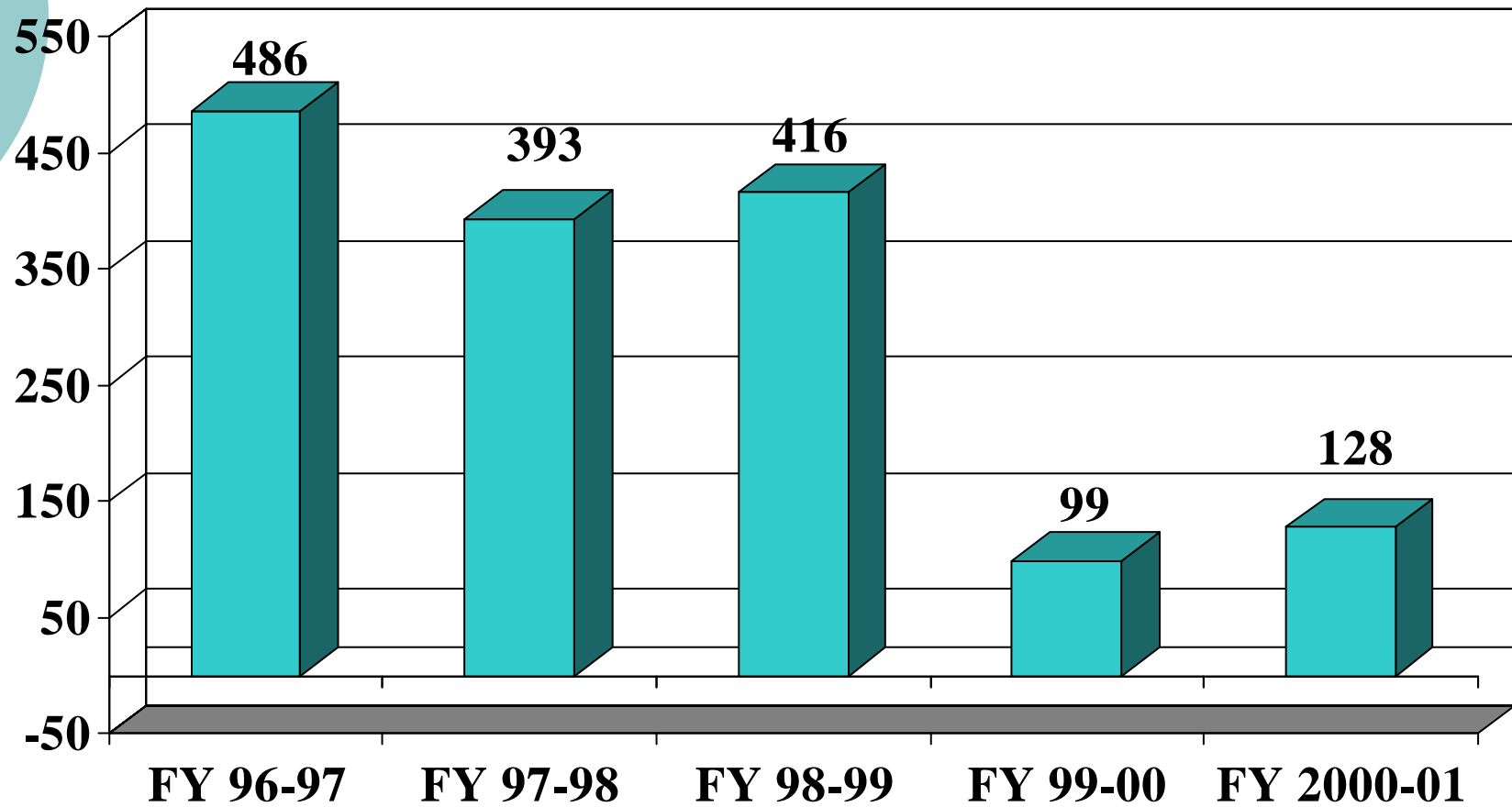
# Hospitalizations for alcohol dependency, Hillsdale County residents ages 15+, 1995-99, 18+ for 2001

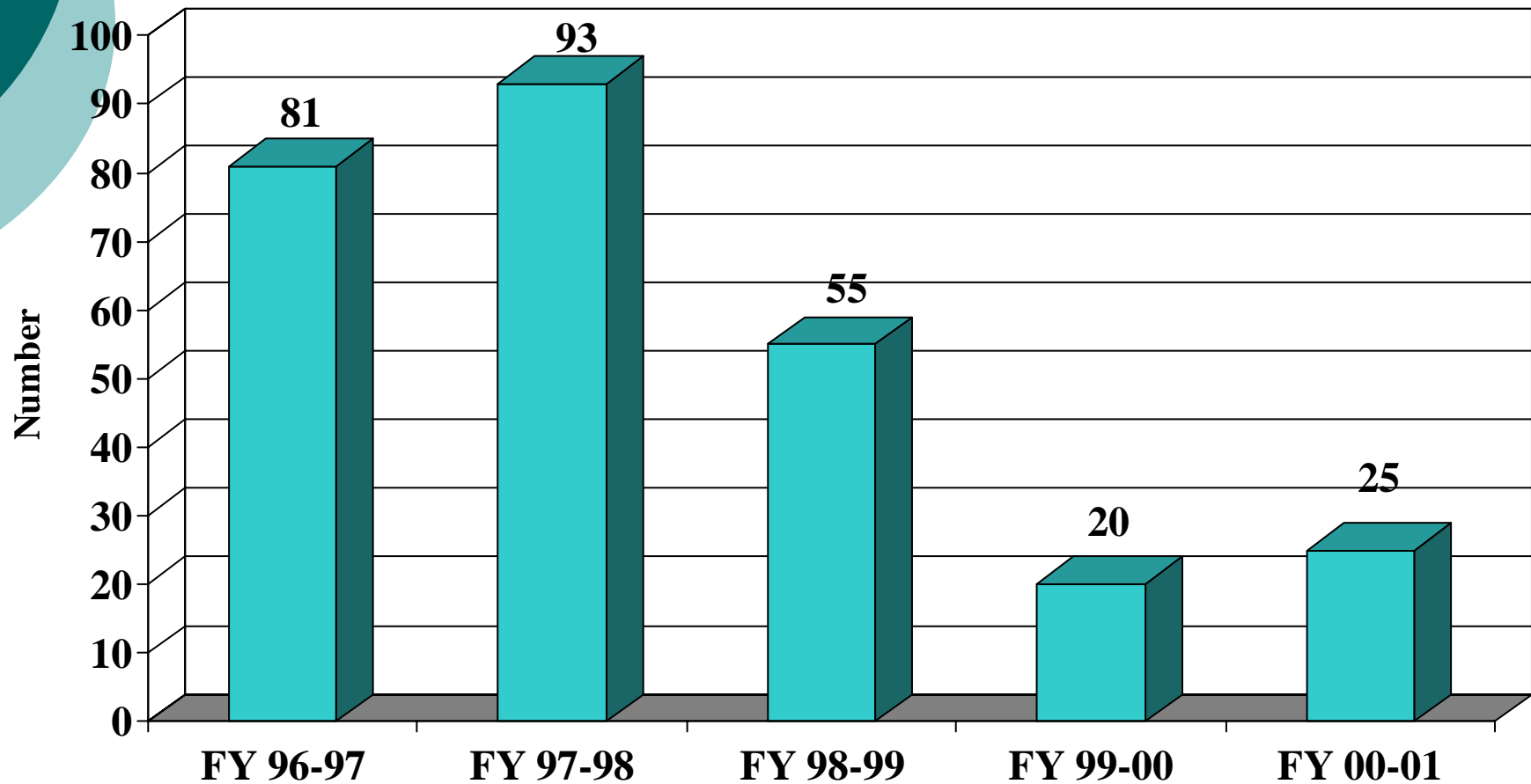
Number of Hillsdale residents admitted for alcohol treatment, Mid-South Substance Abuse 1996-2001

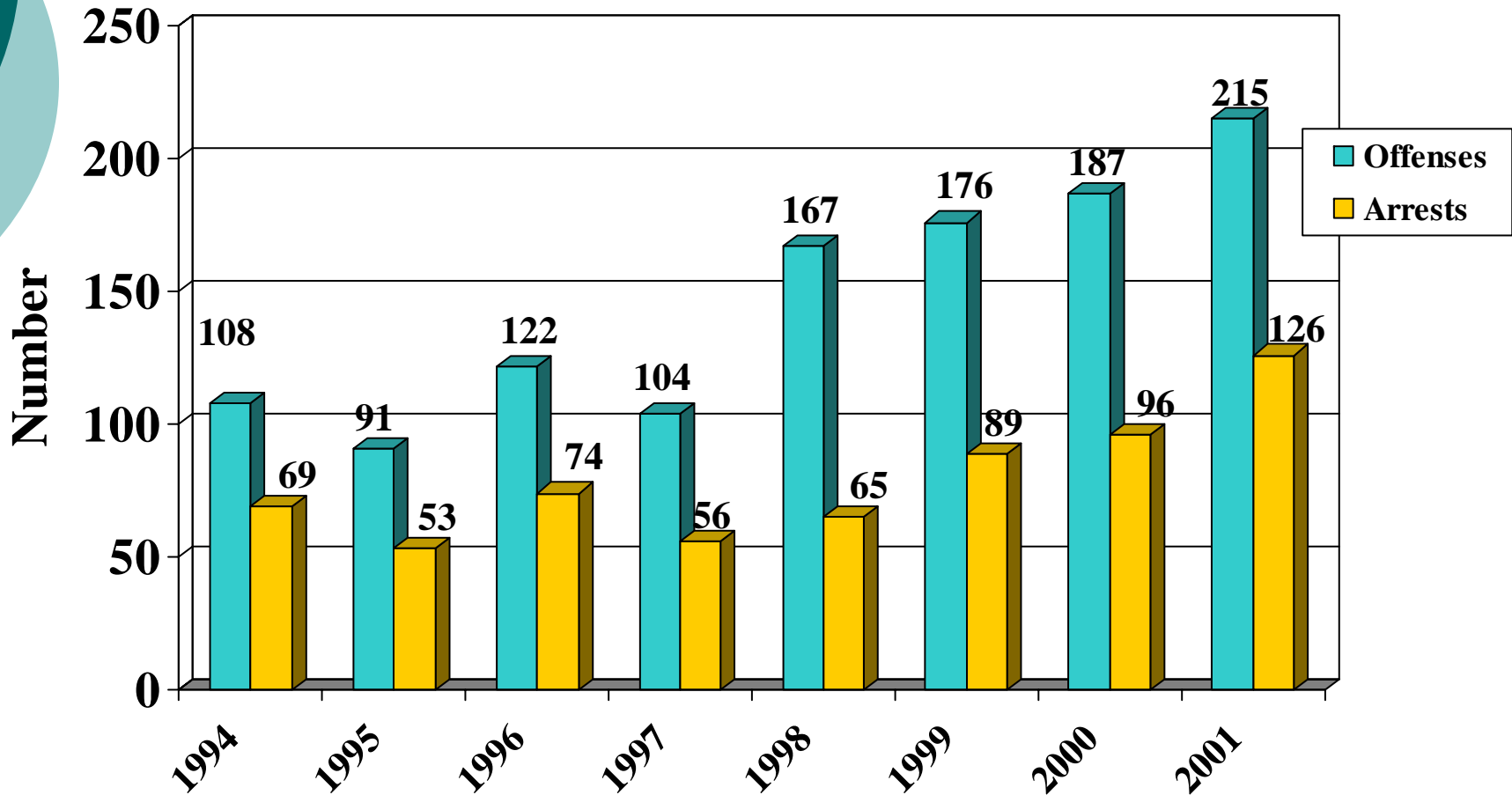

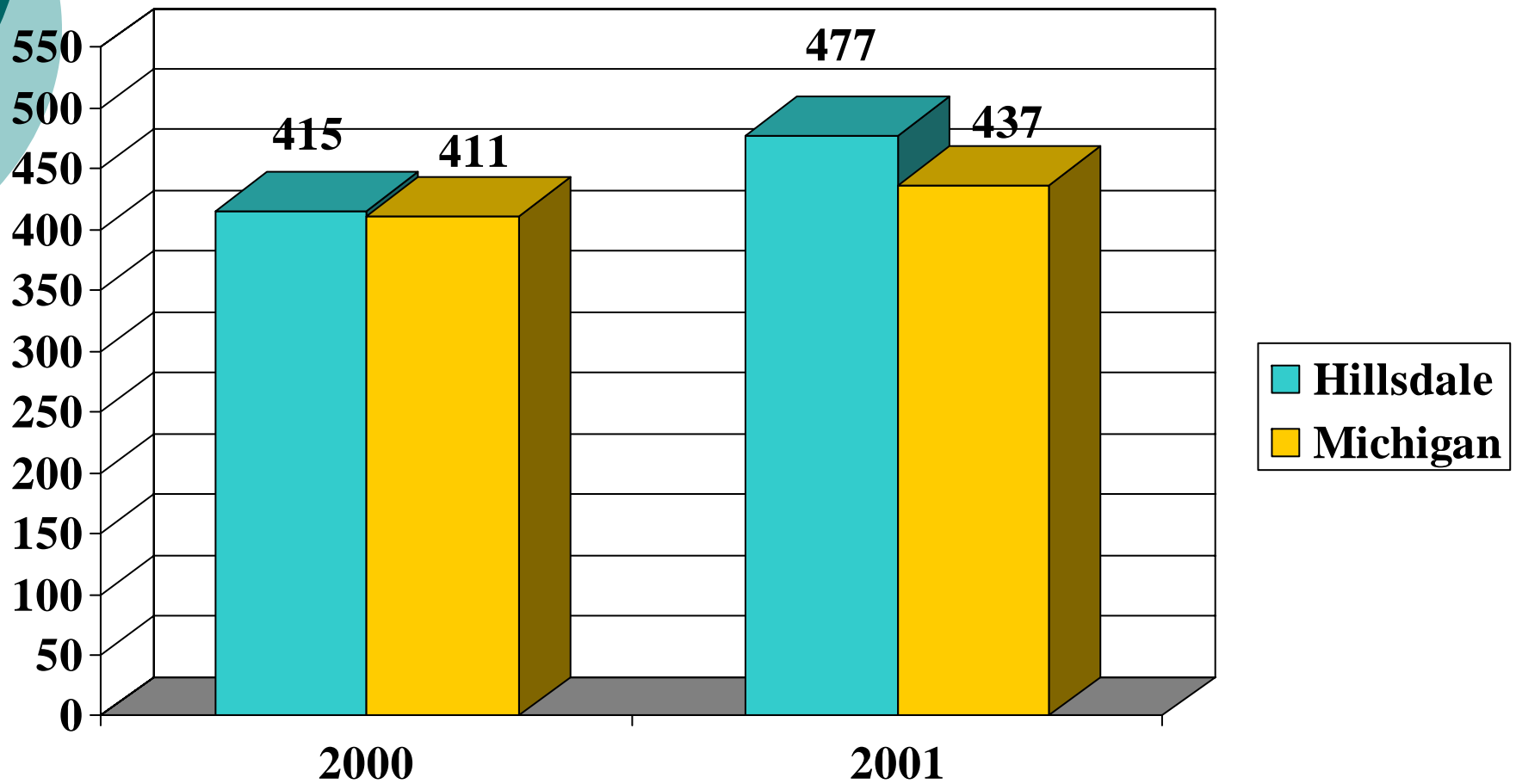
# Offenses and arrests due to narcotic law violations, Hillsdale County, 1990 to 2001

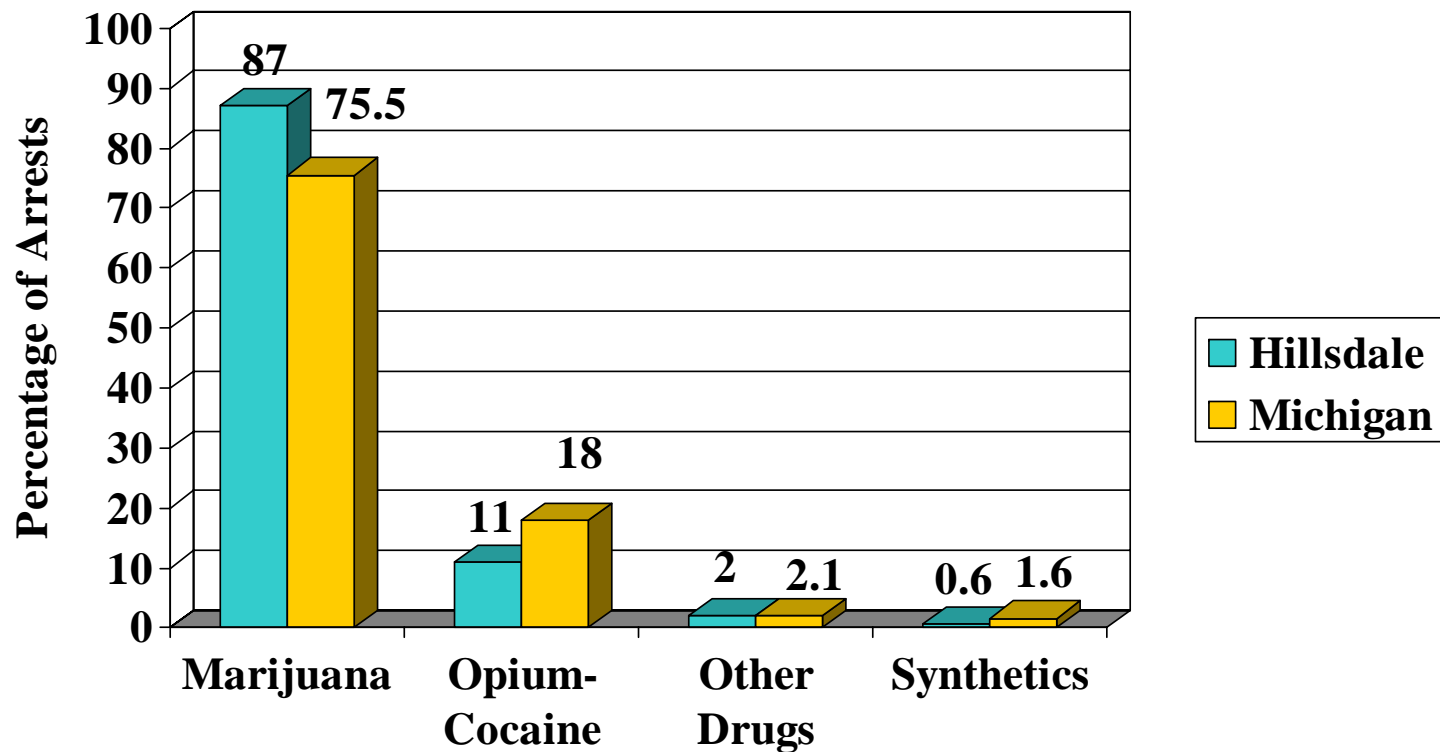
# Narcotic offense rate per 100,000, Hillsdale County & MI, 2000-2001

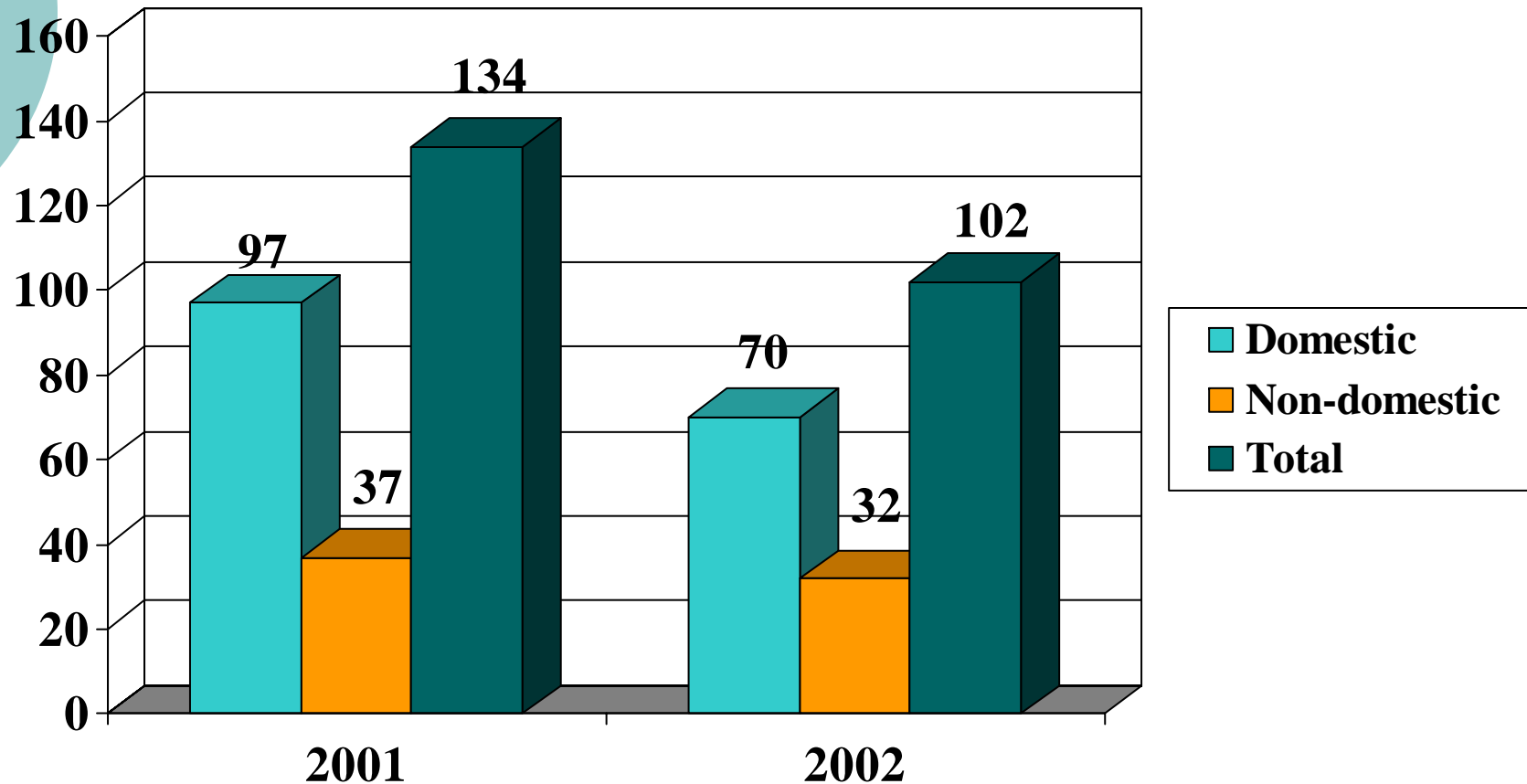

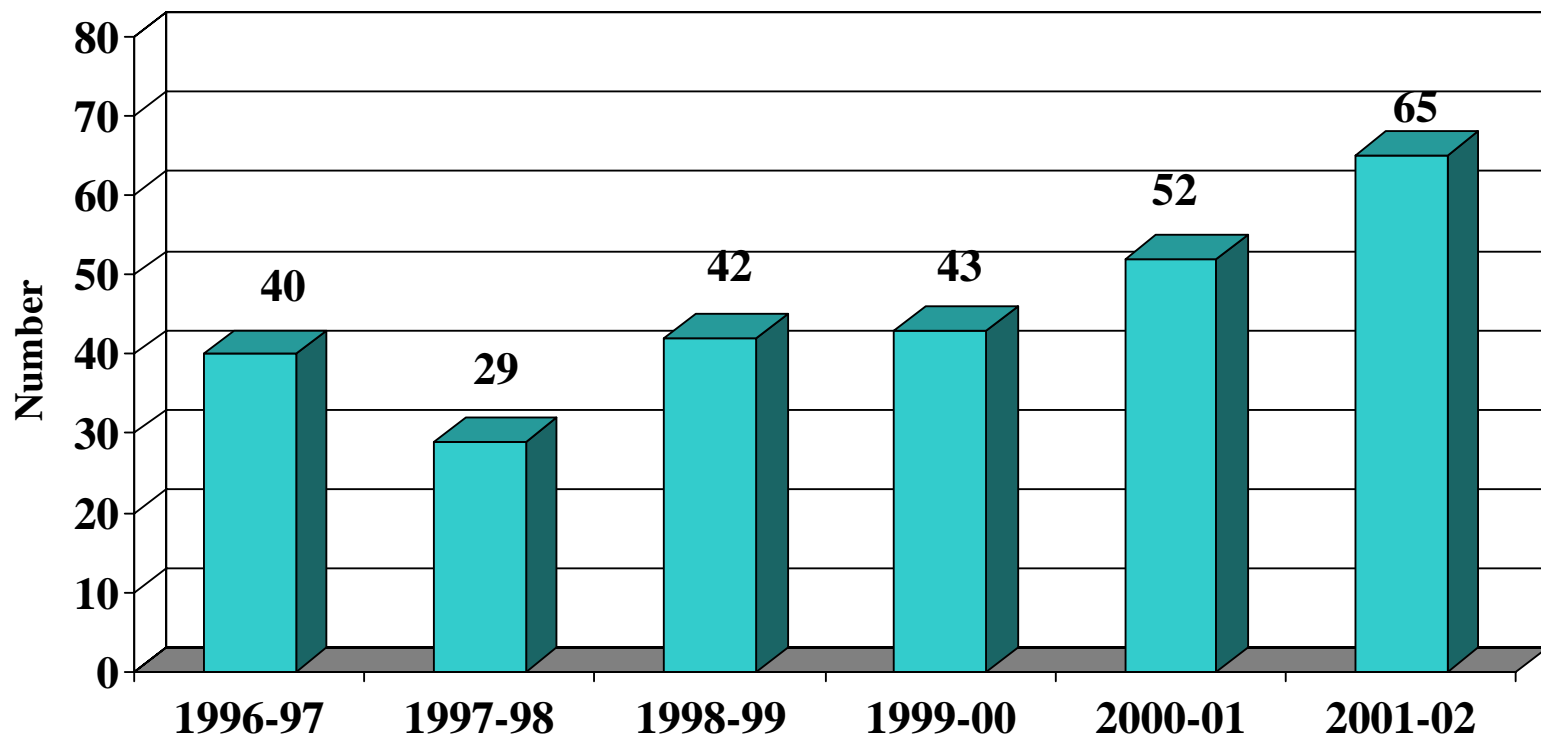

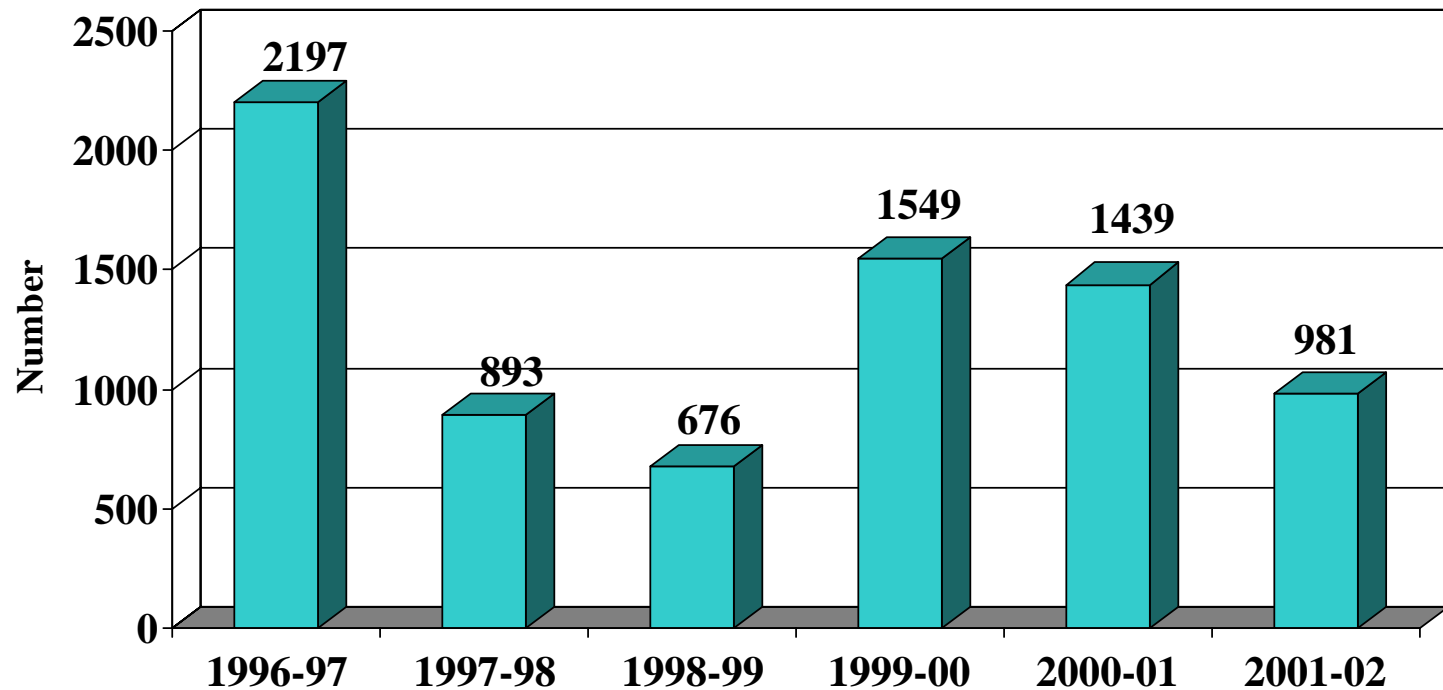
# Number of adults in Hillsdale seeking shelter for domestic violence 1996-2002

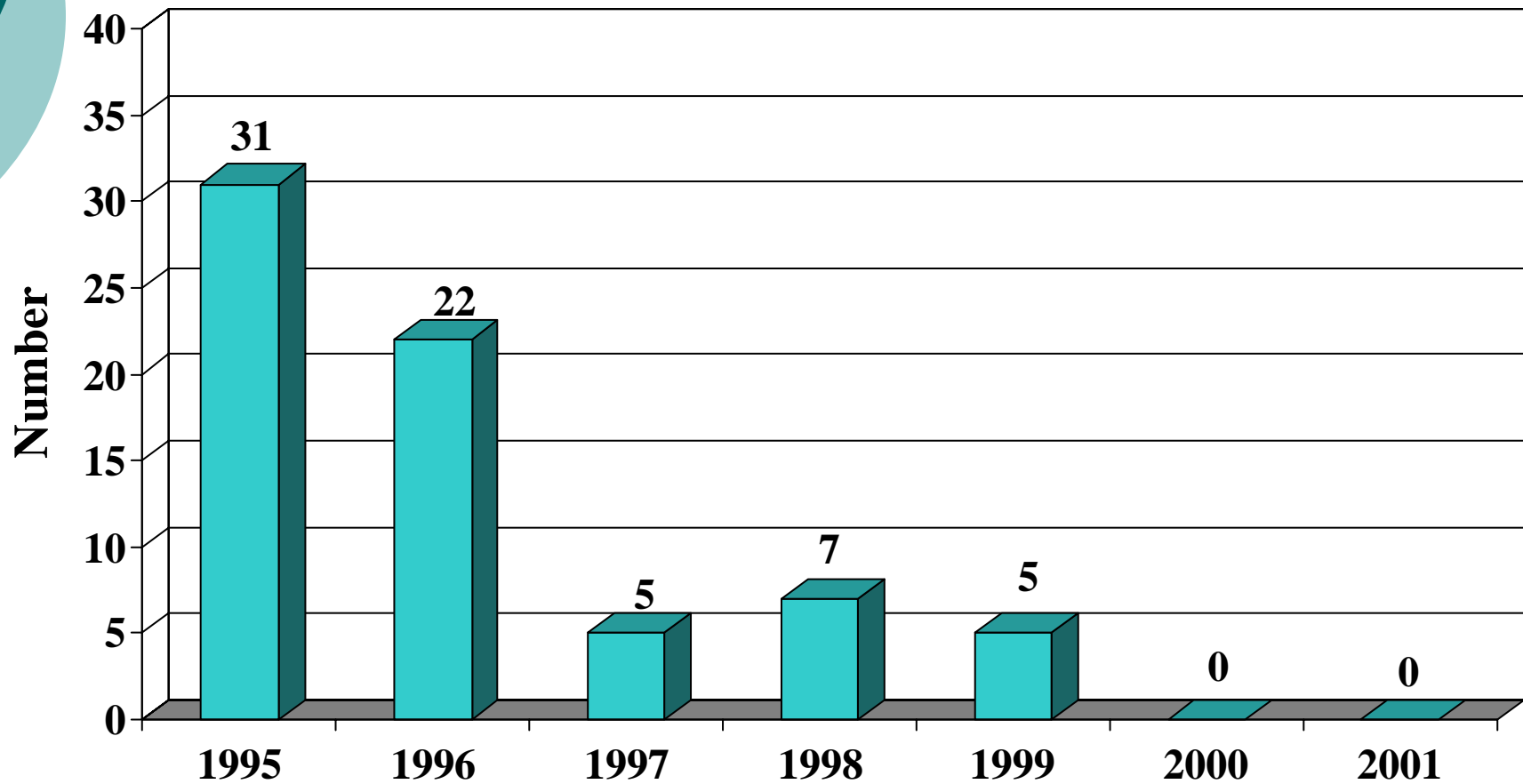
# Number of adult resident nights provided by Domestic Violence Shelter 1996-2002

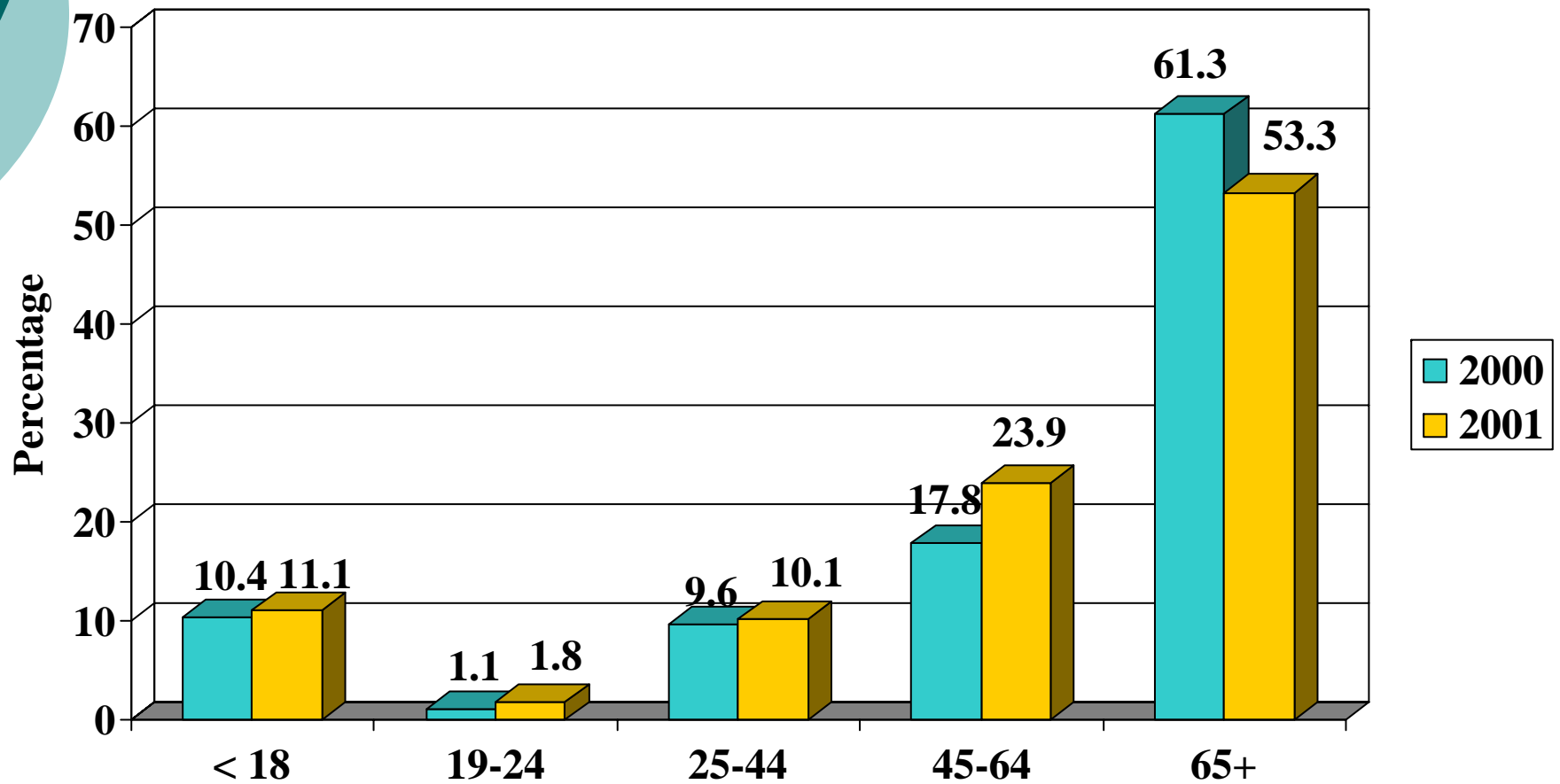

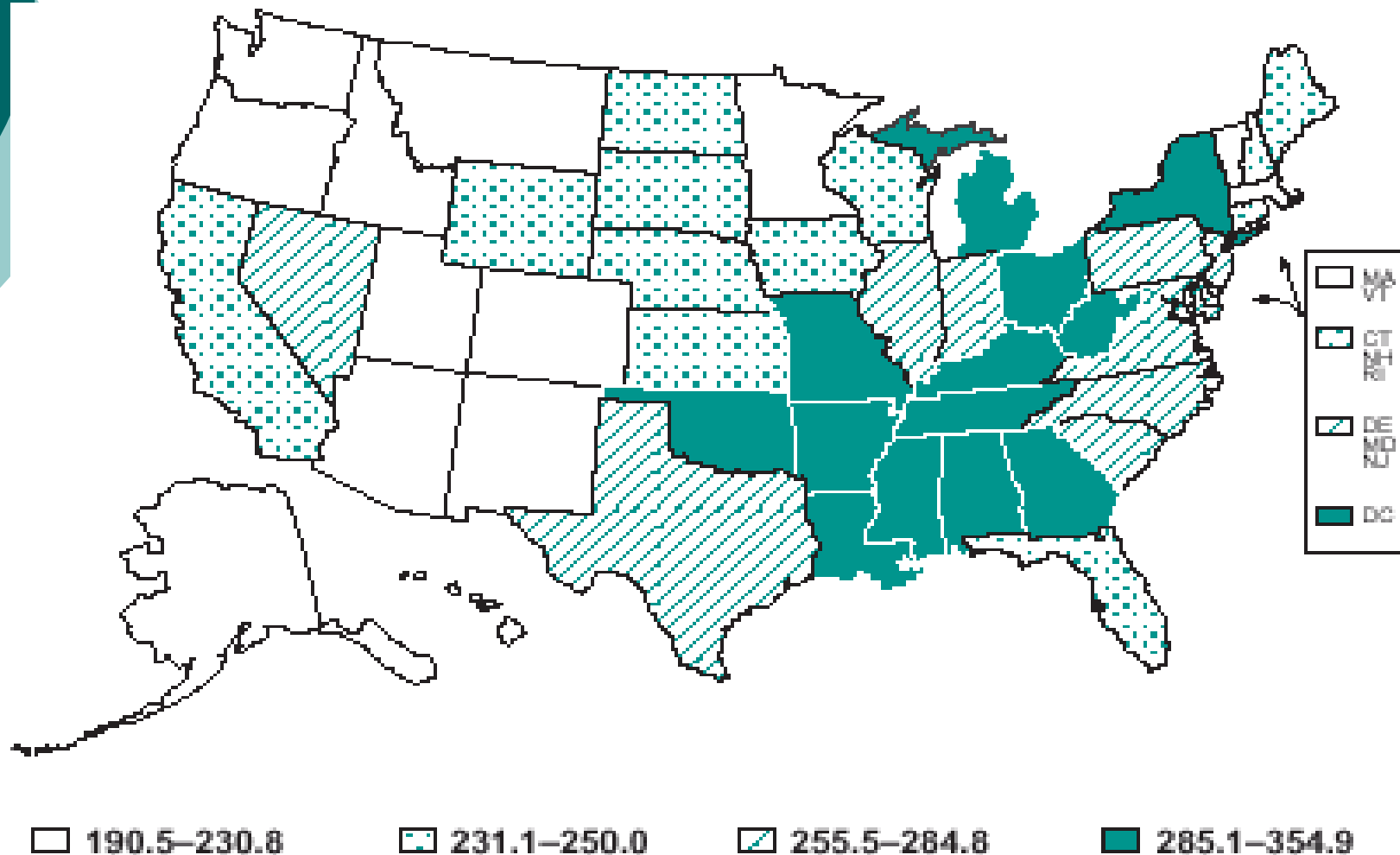

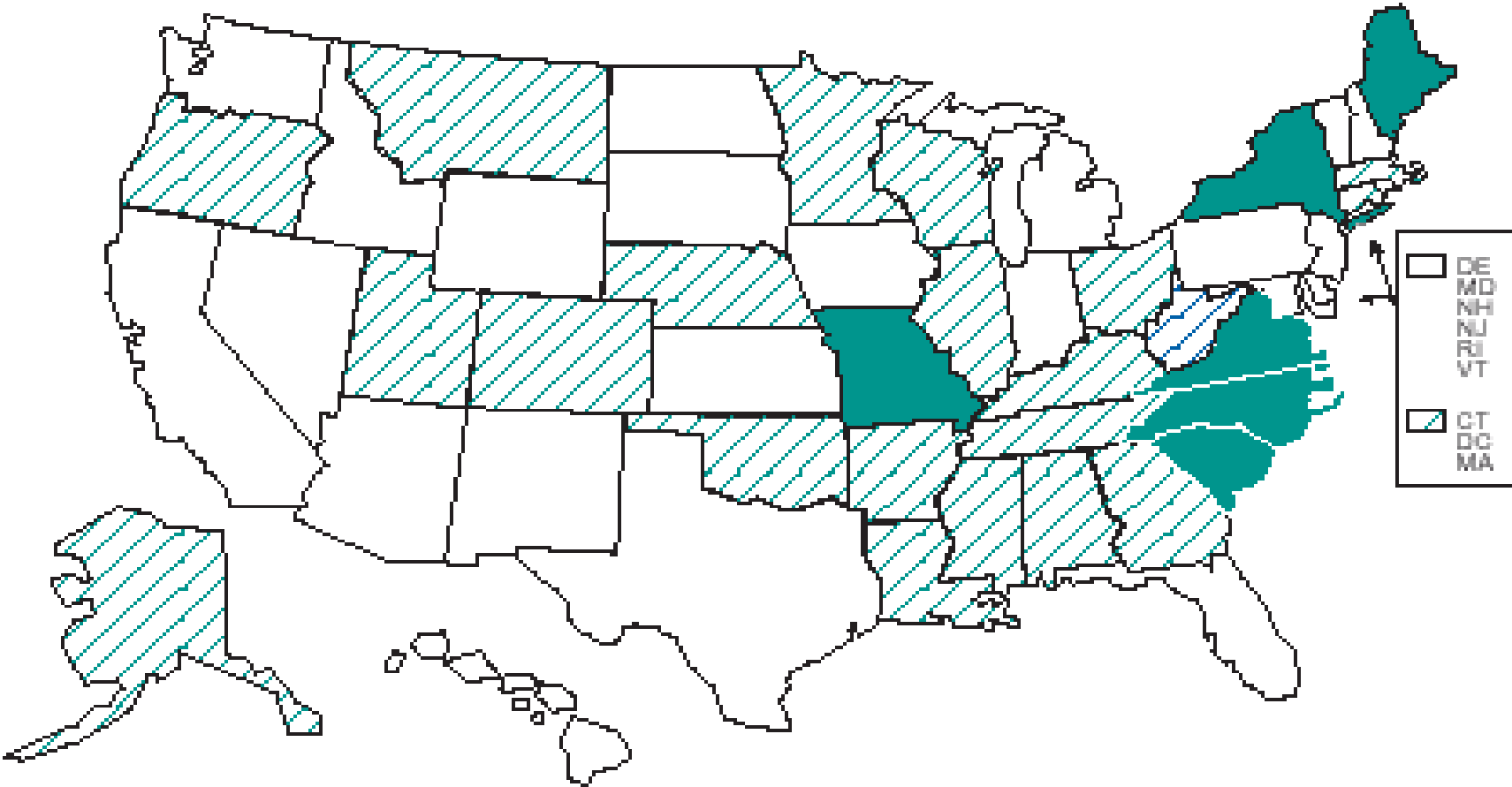
# Rates of Death due to diseases of the Heart

# Cancer terminology - Stage definitions

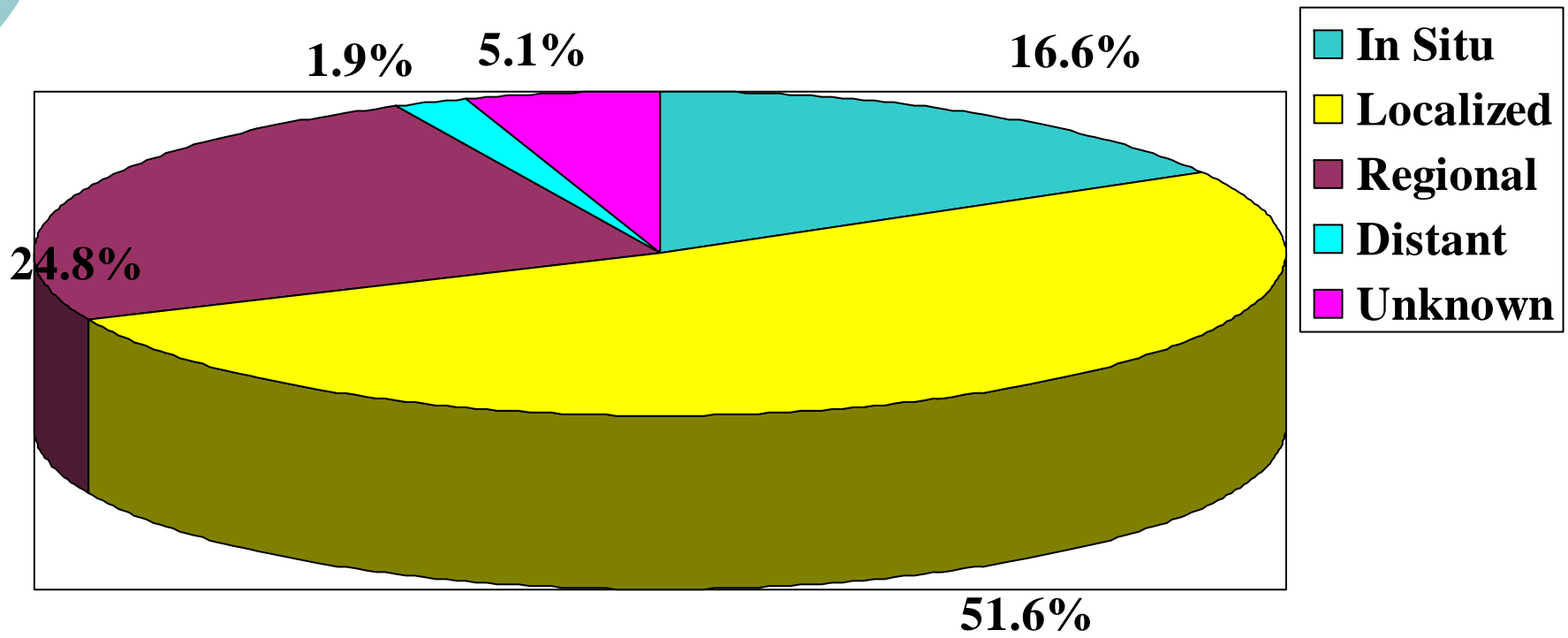
(stuff you would rather not have to hear)

---

- *In Situ* – Presence of malignant cells within the cell group from which they arose.
- *Localized* – invasive cancer confined to the organ of origin
- *Regional* – direct extension to adjacent organs or tissues or involvement in the regional lymph nodes.
- *Distant* – continuation to non-adjacent organs, involvement of the distant lymph nodes

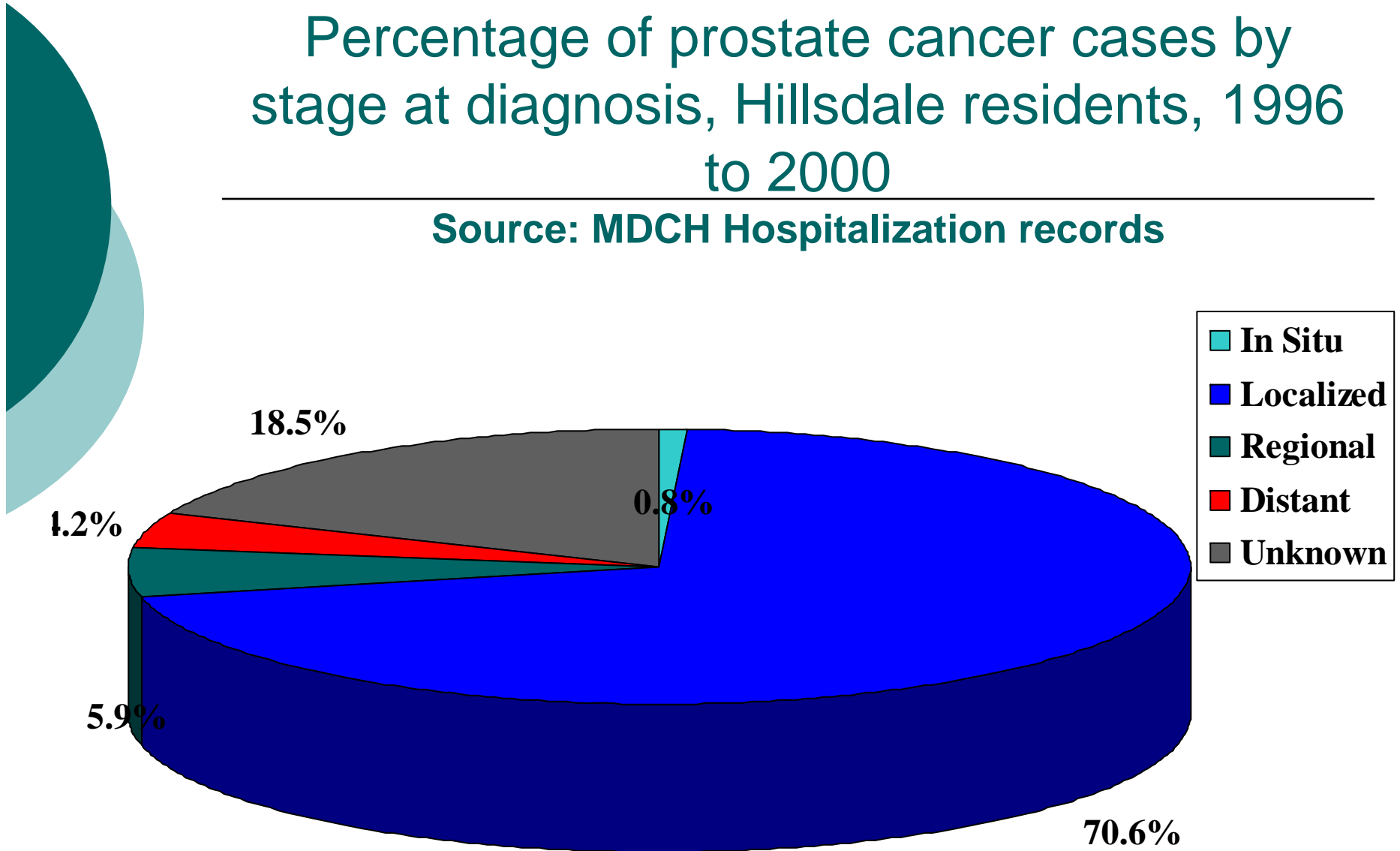
# Percentage of breast cancer cases by stage at diagnosis, Hillsdale Residents, 1996-2000

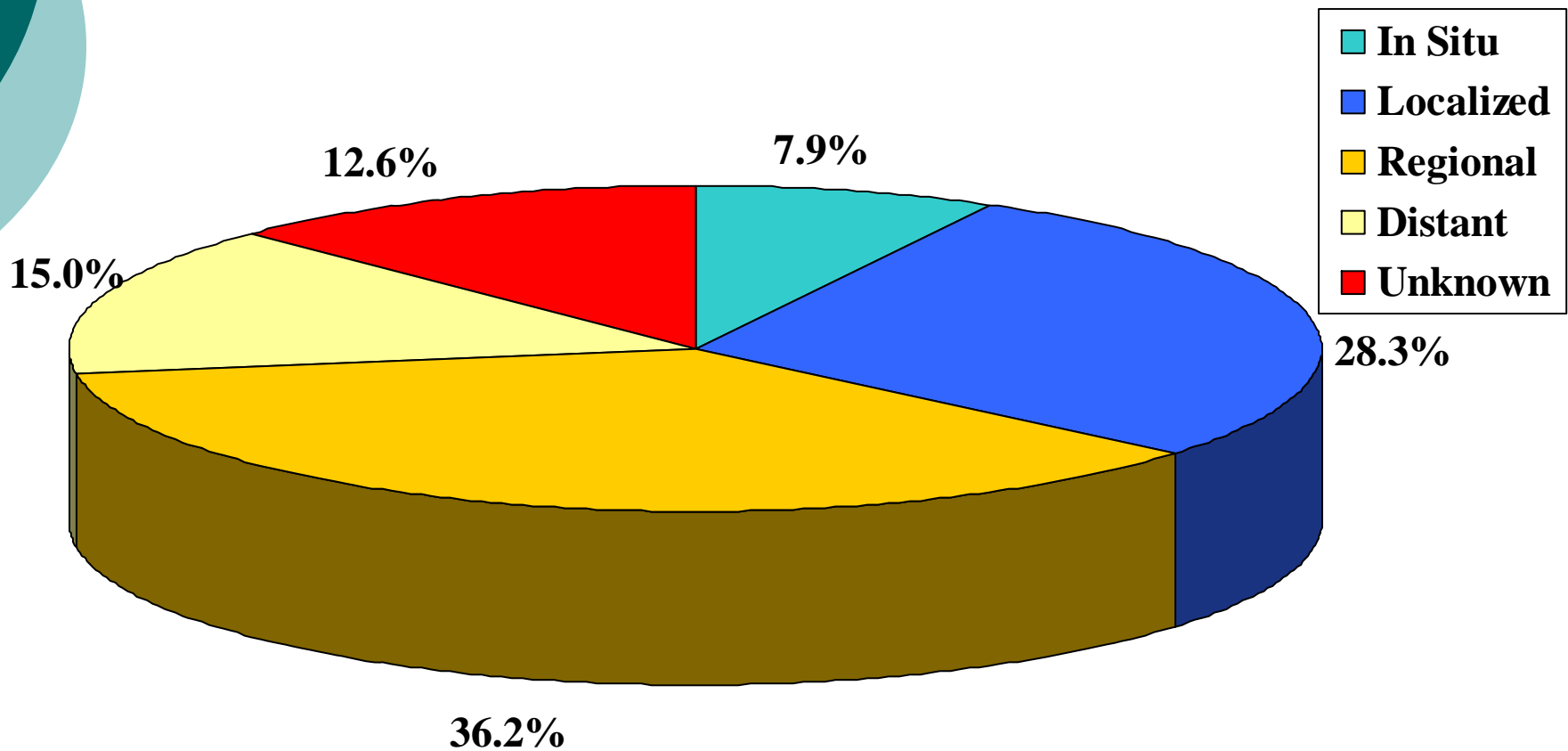
# Percentage of prostate cancer cases by stage at diagnosis, Hillsdale residents, 1996 to 2000

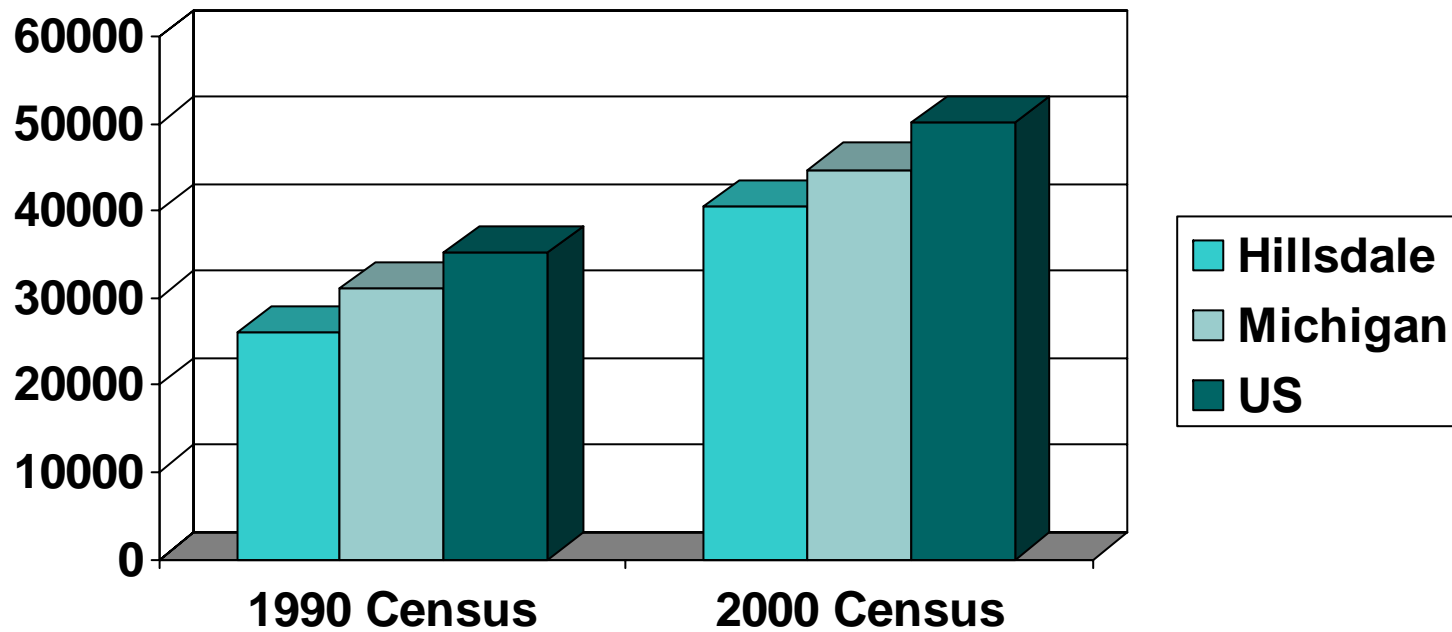




# Median Family Income

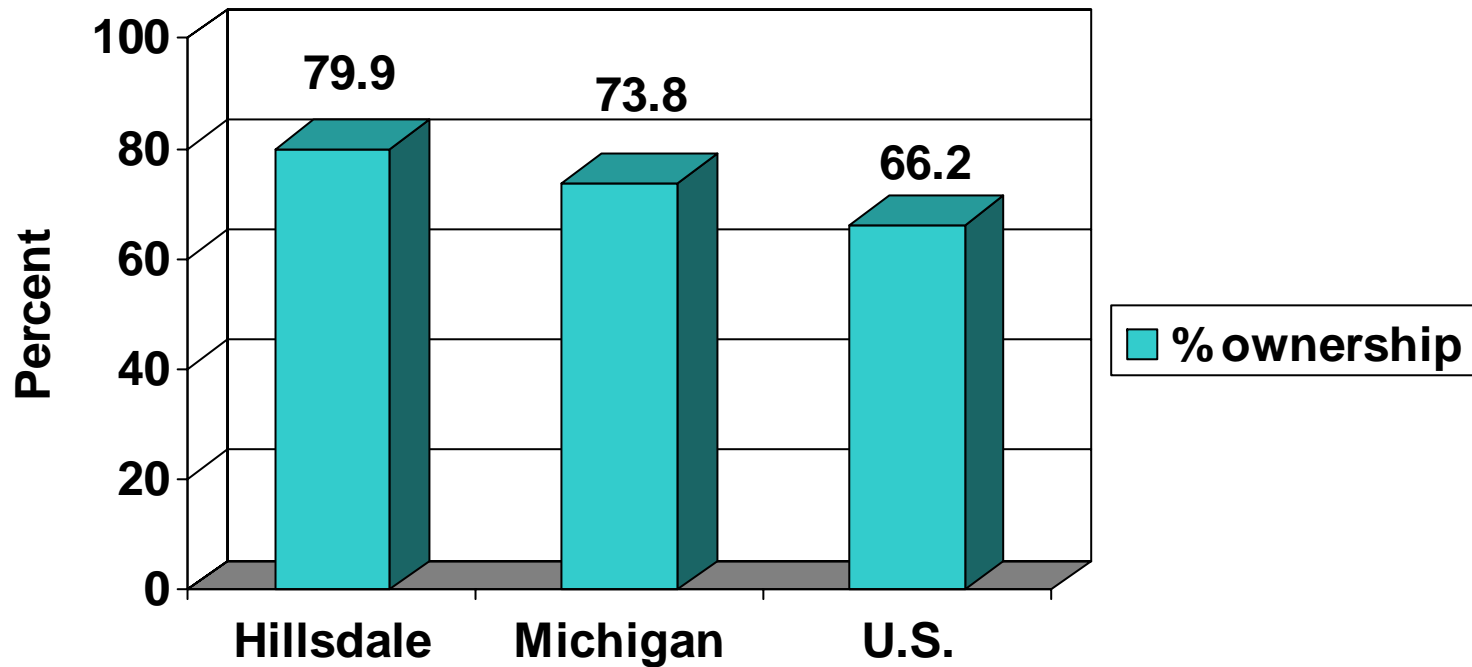

# Home Ownership Hillsdale County vs. Michigan

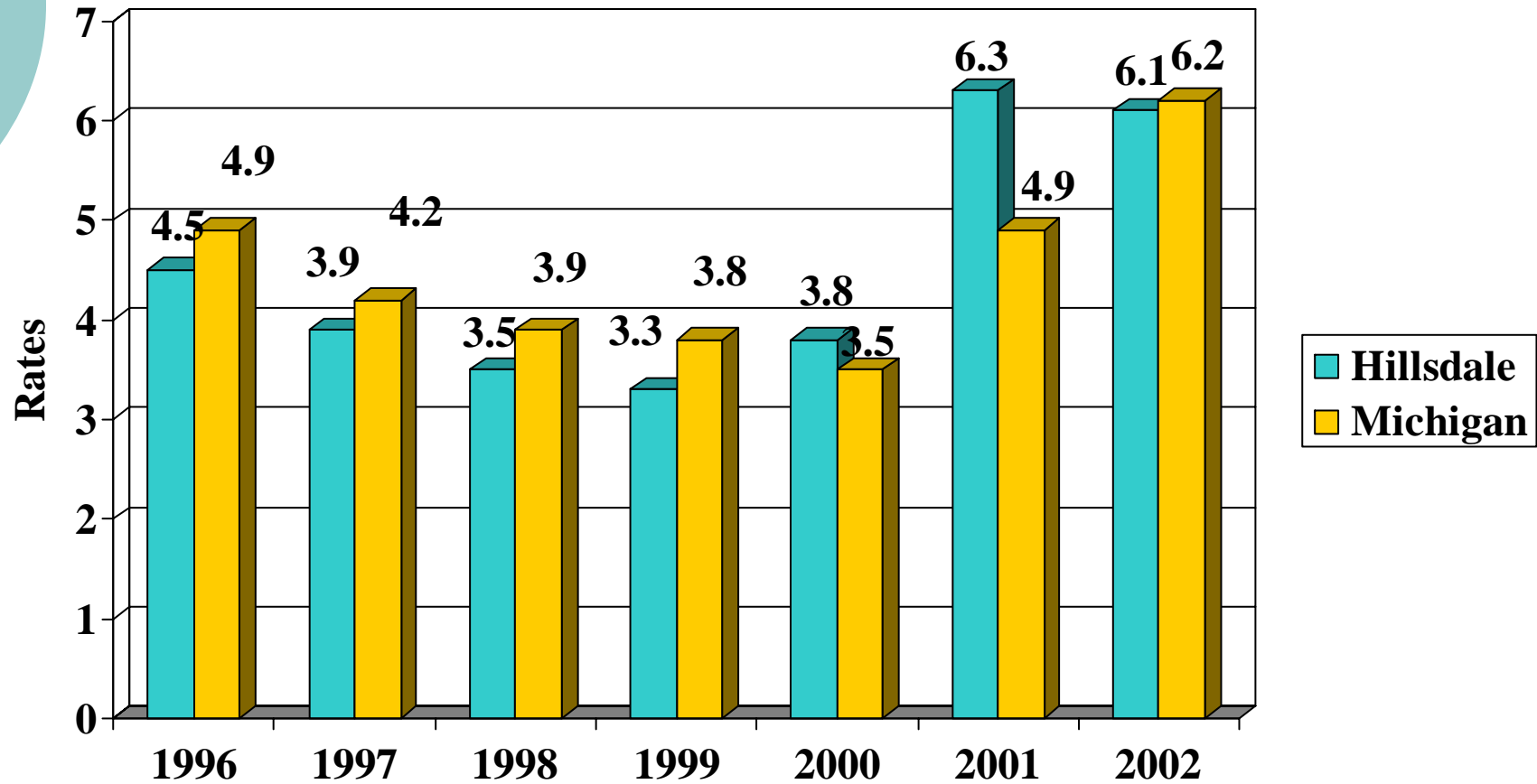

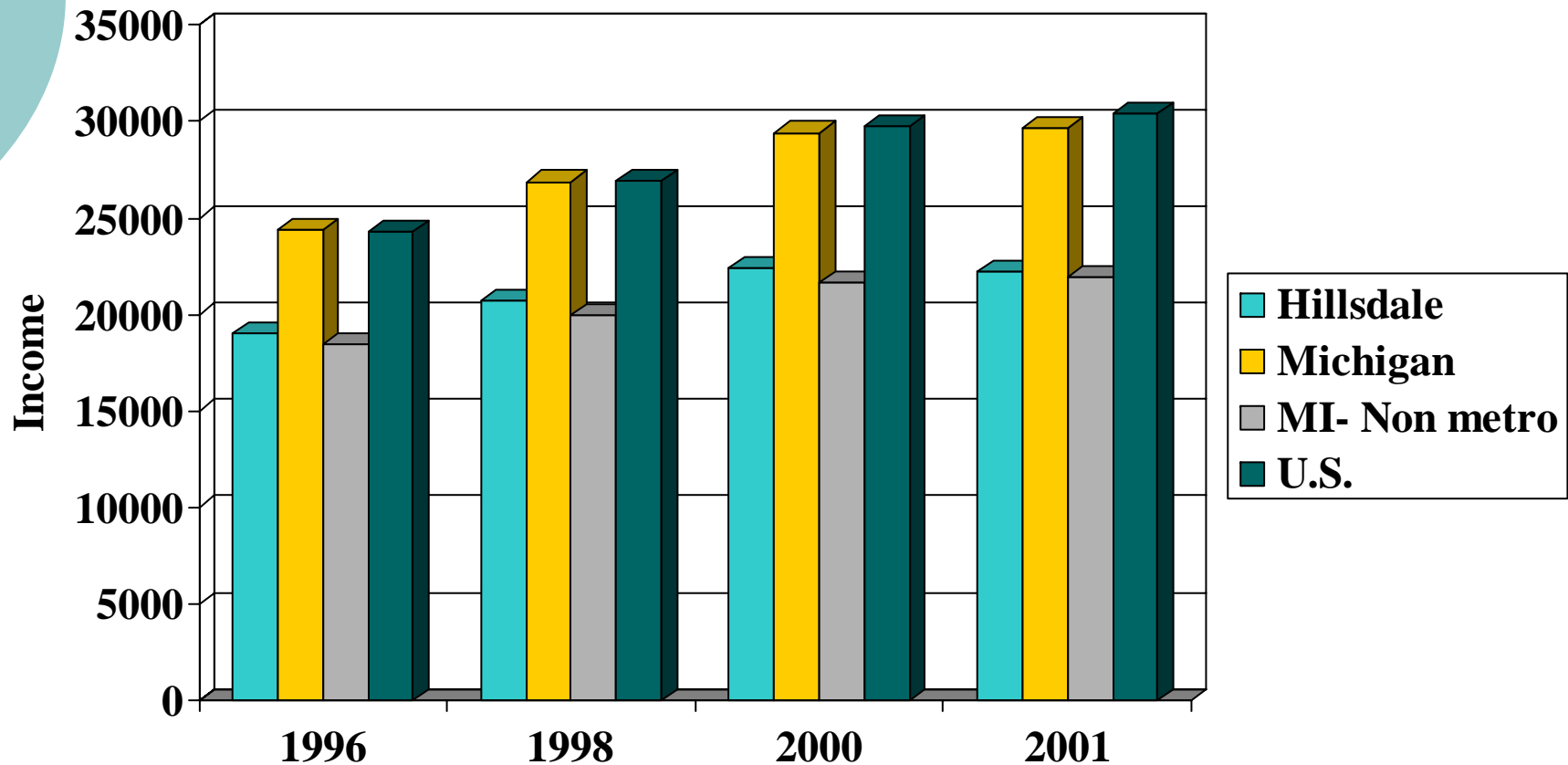
# Average, non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rates, Hillsdale & Michigan
