## **Accounting Error Identified**

It appears that there was an error in calcuating the total population for the per capita funding in Branch County in 2012. The base population from 2000 was used when subtracting the 3,169 prisoners, resulting in a total population of 42,618 (45,787-3,169=42,618). The base population from the 2010 census should have been used, which would have resulted in a total population of 42,079 (45,248-3,169=42,079). This error in population was continued every year, resulting in over payment totaling \$25,671 over the combine ten year time period.

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

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


## GROUP QUARTERS POPULATION BY MAJOR GROUP QUARTERS TYPE




