

## COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic Client Instructions

**If you have any symptoms of COVID-19; fever, cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell, headache, sore throat, runny nose, nausea, diarrhea, chills, fatigue, you may not receive the vaccination today. You must go home and isolate until you can be tested for COVID-19 or your symptoms resolve after 10 days of isolation.**

**If you have had a close contact exposure with an individual positive for COVID-19 and must quarantine, you may not enter the building to receive a vaccine today.**

**Thank you for helping protect the workers and volunteers at this clinic.**

1. Fill out the consent form completely before entering the building.
2. Enter the building at your appointment time with a mask covering your nose and mouth. You will be screened and have your temperature taken upon entry. **Do not enter the building early.**
3. You must keep 6 feet of social distance from others while at the clinic, except for necessary interactions with workers who provide your vaccination.
4. Check-in at the Registration desk, present your consent form and follow the directions of the workers.
5. Once you have received your vaccination you must take a seat in the observation area for 15 to 30 minutes depending on instructions from the medical team before you can leave. You may leave the building once your observation period has ended.
6. You must schedule your second dose appointment prior to leaving the building. Please do this using your smartphone while waiting in the observation area using the QR code provided. If you have any problems making your second dose appointment, please stop at the station next to the exit.
7. After leaving, please consider signing up for V-safe so that you can report any side-effects of the vaccination. You have been provided an information sheet about V-safe.

**We look forward to seeing you back for your second dose. It is important that you continue to keep socially distant from others not in your household, wash your hands, and wear a mask outside of your home. Thank you for doing your part to help stop the virus.**
